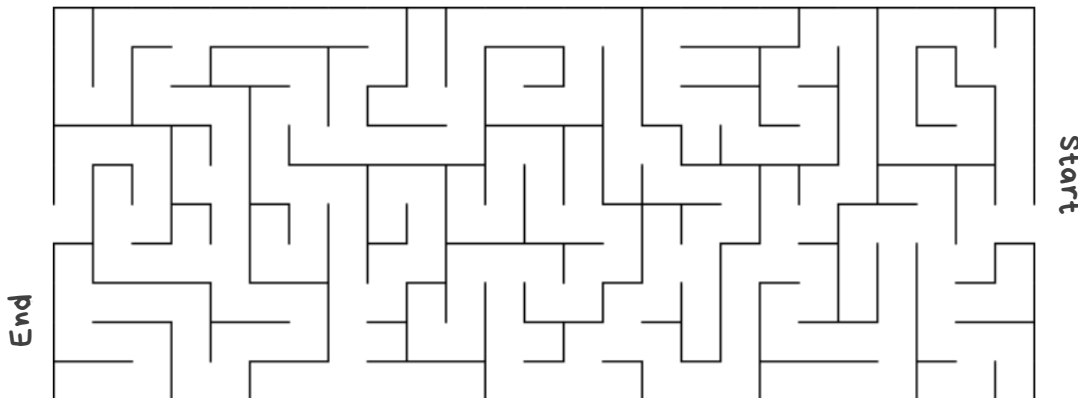


Bible Lessons

Mark 7:(24-30),31-37

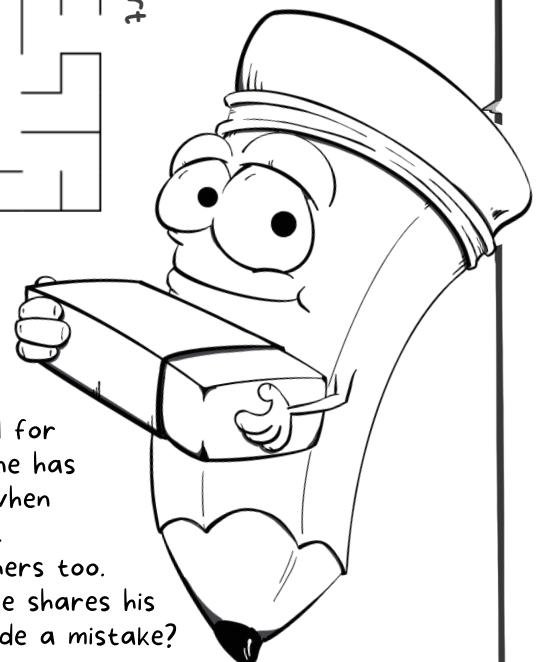
Today we hear

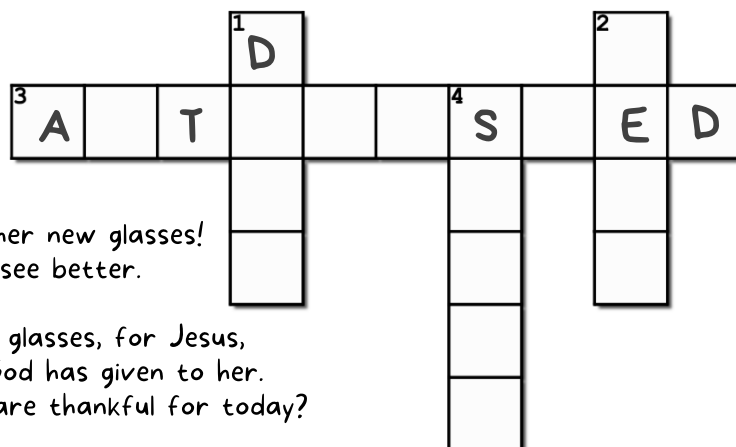
