Health Requirements

- (A) Llamas moved within Ohio for exhibition when presented for exhibition must show no evidence of contagious or infectious disease.
- (B) Llamas imported into Ohio for exhibition must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection issued within thirty (30) days and must not show any signs of contagious or infectious disease at exhibition.

Registration Requirements:

All llamas five months or older entered in approved classes, with the exception of Youth Classes and Non-Breeder, must be registered with the International Lama Registry(ILR). **Copies of registration papers are not required but entry must clearly show registration number of all entries and owners' ILR Owner Code.**

Youth Ages: Junior 7-11; Intermediate 12-14, Senior 15-19 as of January 1st. Those that have their seventh birthday during the year are eligible to show as of that day.

Awards: Ribbons & premiums to 4 places, Youth to 5 places (amount according to entries).

Grand & Reserve Champions

Best-of- Show Male – All Male and Non-Breeder Grand Champions eligible

Best-of-Show Female – All Female Grand Champion eligible

Non-Breeder – Class to be split depending upon entries received

Production Pair Class – You may count this class as your 'second' entry for your llamas, even though you are entering the Dam or Sire. **Please be sure to fill out a separate box for this entry, listing the information about the Sire or Dam and also which animals will actually be shown. Remember to include the appropriate animal fee (ILR-SD fee of \$3) for your Dam and/or Sire on the entry form.**

Youth Exhibitors: Youth cannot enter the same animal in both the youth performance classes and open performance classes. They must take a different animal through the open classes. Youth may not share animals.

Silent Auction: ORVLA will be sponsoring a Silent Auction during this show. Please bring an item with you for this auction. All proceeds benefit ORVLA programs.

Show Sponsors: ORVLA invites farms and/or businesses to be sponsors for this show.
