**BAPTISM STIPEND - \$25.00** - Baptisms are celebrated by appointment (after a Baptism Preparation Course has been completed).

**BAPTISM PREPARATION:** The baptism of a child is a very important event in the life of the child, the child's family, and the parish community. To help parents enter more fully into the celebration of their child's baptism, St. Joseph's Parish offers a Baptism Preparation Course by appointment. Parents along with godparents are expected to attend the Baptism Preparation Course before the baptism of the child. Please call the Parish Office to register.

**MARRIAGE STIPEND - \$200.00** - Please allow at least six months between the time of contacting the Parish and the date of the Marriage. A Marriage Preparation Course is required.

**FUNERAL STIPEND - \$200.00** - St. Joseph's Parish has a Bereavement Committee which will contact you to coordinate the funeral services.

If you are new to the parish or you do not have offertory envelopes and would like to, please contact the Parish Office at 256-3151 and a box will be provided for you. The parish also offers direct deposit for contributions. 2022 envelopes are available at the Office. Income Tax Receipts for 2021 are also available.

The 2021-2022 Living with Christ Sunday Missal is available at the Parish Office for \$5.00 each. The Sunday Missal contains complete readings and Mass texts, as well as selected hymns for Sundays and feast days for the entire Church year.

**August 2 - Memorial of Saint Peter Julian Eymard, Priest:** Born in France, Julian (1811-1868) desired to become a Priest but at first had to study secretly because his father refused to allow him to enter the Priesthood. When he was 18, however, his father granted permission and Julian was ordained in 1834. He established the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament, a group of men dedicated to adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Julian is considered a pioneer in the rediscovery of the importance of the 'bread of life' and in his call to involve the laity more actively in the Church. He was canonized in 1962.

**August 5 - Memorial of Blessed Frédéric Janssoone, Priest:** Ordained in 1870, Frédéric was sent to the Holy Land in 1876. He encouraged pilgrimages to the Holy Land, reinstated the Stations of the Cross through the streets of Jerusalem, built a Church in Bethlehem, and negotiated an accord among the Roman, Greek, and Armenian Christians concerning the use and maintenance of the sanctuaries of Bethlehem and of the Holy Sepulchre. In 1888, Frédéric moved to Canada and set about helping organizers develop the Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Rosary (Notre-dame-du-Cap) at Cap-de-la-Madeleine near Trois-Rivières. He died in 1916 and was beatified in 1988 by Pope John Paul II.

**August 5 - Memorial of the Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major:** This basilica, built in the 4<sup>th</sup> century under Pope Liberius, was first called the Liberian Basilica. However, after the Council of Ephesus (431) proclaimed Mary the Mother of God, the Church was repaired and reconsecrated about the year 435 as the Basilica of the Virgin Mary. It is called Saint Mary Major (Great Saint Mary's) because it is older and larger than other Roman Churches also dedicated to Our Lady.

**AUGUST 6 - FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD:** This Feast has been observed on this day by the universal Church since the 15<sup>th</sup> century. Today we are encouraged to pray and reflect on the biblical account of the Transfiguration (Mark 9.2-10). The account of the Transfiguration is an awe-inspiring indication of the resplendent glory that belongs to Jesus as God's unique Son. However, following his transfiguration, Jesus moves steadily toward his death. Thus, we must not lose sight of the broader message: Whoever follows Jesus must be willing to do what he did and so renounce glory in exchange for suffering.

**August 7 - Memorial of Saint Sixtus II, Pope, and Companions, Martyrs:** Sixtus succeeded Stephen I as Pope in the year 257. That same year, persecution of Christians began, and the next year Sixtus and several of his deacons were put to death in a catacomb where they celebrated Mass. Sixtus had offered himself to prevent the arrest of others and was beheaded while speaking to the assembly. Sixtus was buried in the papal tomb, and his relics are located and venerated in the old Church of Saint Sixtus in Rome.

**August 7 - Memorial of Saint Cajetan, Priest:** Born in Vicenza in 1480, Cajetan joined a confraternity called the Roman Order of Divine Love in 1516 and was ordained the same year. He devoted himself to serving the poor and the sick. In 1524, he formed a society of clerks regular called the Theatines. When Spaniards plundered Rome in 1527, they tortured the Theatines in the mistaken belief that they had hidden treasure. He died in Naples in 1547.
