

Japan Teaching Internships (Summer, 2017)

GHJ Internship Overview

Guy Healy, Japan has been providing Teaching Internships in Japan through our ENG Program for the past ten years. More than 100 interns have participated in the program. The ENG program offers three positions per term but as it is funded by a Catholic Girl's School it is only offered for female interns.

This summer we will add five new intern positions as part of the Asia-Pacific TEFL program. This program will provide teacher training, teaching experience at all age-levels, and award a TEFL Certificate to the participating interns. This program will provide teaching experience at both public and private schools as well as the opportunity to work with teachers in Japan participating on the JET Program.

The main differences in these two internship programs are: A) the ENG Program covers major costs including airfare and housing, but does not offer a TEFL Certificate or the same type of training. B) the Asia Pacific TEFL Program requires fees to the participants but offers both the TEFL Certificate and a more well-rounded training program.

However, for this summer term we have a new plan to make these two programs more similar and offer the benefits of both to all applicants and selected participants. Those applying for and selected to the ENG Program will have the option to pay a tuition fee to join the training sessions of the TEFL program as well as earn the TEFL Certificate. And, we are offering scholarships to those applying for and selected to the Asia Pacific TEFL internship program that will cover airfare and housing in Japan.

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“Option”: ENG Interns can also join the TEFL Training Sessions of the Asia-Pacific TEFL program and earn a TEFL Certificate, but will be required to pay that program tuition (see below).

Internship Program Fees

All internship are non-salaried but do cover certain expenses as described below.

Meal Expense: Approximately \$50-\$75/week. (Clubhouse Kitchen)

Travel Insurance: \$22-\$50 (If not covered by own insurance)

*TEFL Housing and Air Travel to Japan will be covered by our program scholarship funds, unless intern is receiving credit and financial aid from home university to cover the fees.

GHJ will assist in arranging air ticketing and overseas health insurance.

Applicants will have the option to apply for:

- a. Only the ENG Internship (females only)
- b. ENG Internship + TEFL Certificate Program (females only)
- c. Asia-Pacific TEFL Internship (TEFL Certificate)
- d. All Internships (will accept either position)

Application Deadline: **March 1, 2017***

*Earlier the better as we may make some earlier selections.

Selection Process

Selection Date: **March 15, 2017***

***Note:** Highly qualified applicants or those with a special need can request an expedited selection decision. We do hope to announce some selections by mid-February.

Selection Criteria:

- a. **Qualifications** Education, Experience, Purpose & Future Aspirations
- b. **Reference Evaluations** Two professional references (academic or work)
- c. **Intern Interview**
 - ✧ Finalists will be interviewed either in person or by skype by one of our past interns. We have past interns in many areas of the states that volunteer for this process to help us select qualified interns and help the applicants to better understand the program.
- d. **Director Interview** Guy Healy will interview finalists before selection by phone or skype.
