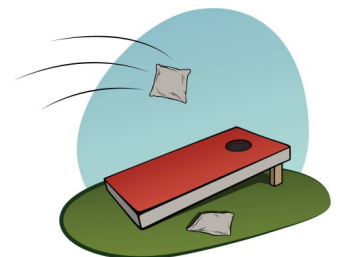

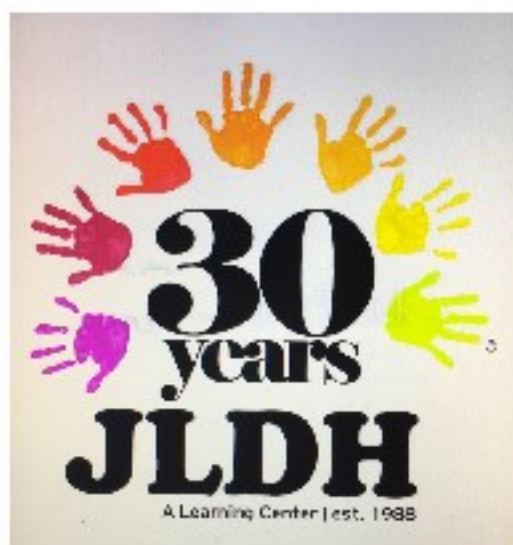

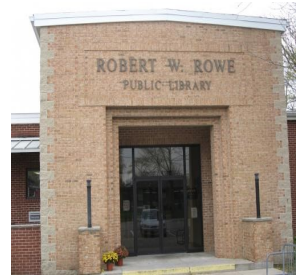

Did you notice the donation cans at the local businesses? We are trying to increase donations for the 4th of July and other holiday events throughout the year.
