In the last Spoke*Notes,* I wrote about the work that MassBike, https://www.massbike.org does in general, and specifically, regarding e-bikes. They are a vast resource regarding "most things" that pertain to bicycle riding in Massachusetts.

Last November, throughout the state, including Springfield, MassBike and other groups sponsored events in recognition of the World Day of Remembrance for victims of traffic crashes. The events recognized fatal crash victims and each person impacted by fatal or serious crashes on our roadways, including bicyclists, motorcyclists and pedestrians. In 2022, 10 bicyclists and many more pedestrians, in Massachusetts tragically lost their lives on our roadways,.
