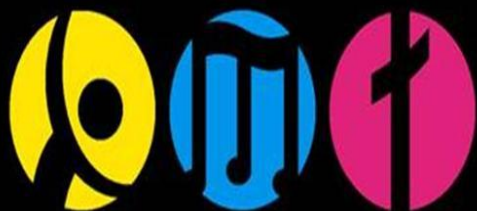

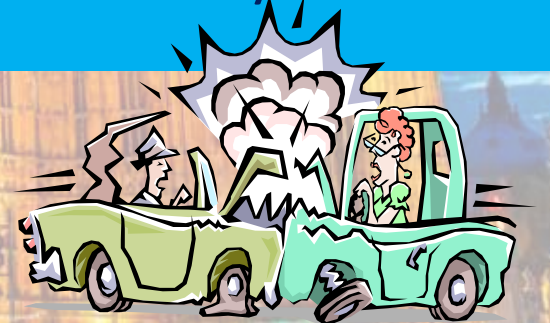
Importance of Being on Time

Check In / Check Out

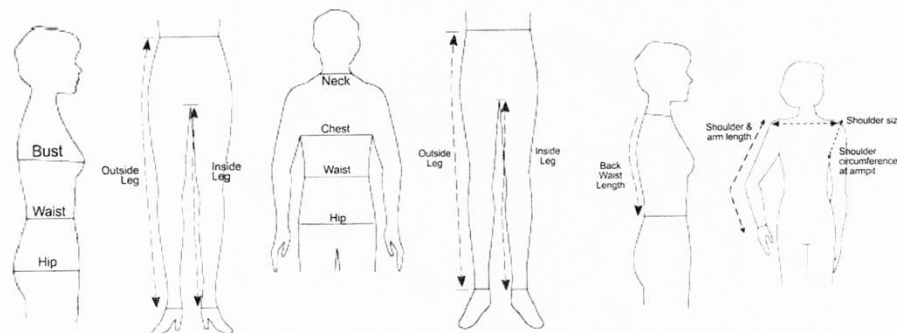

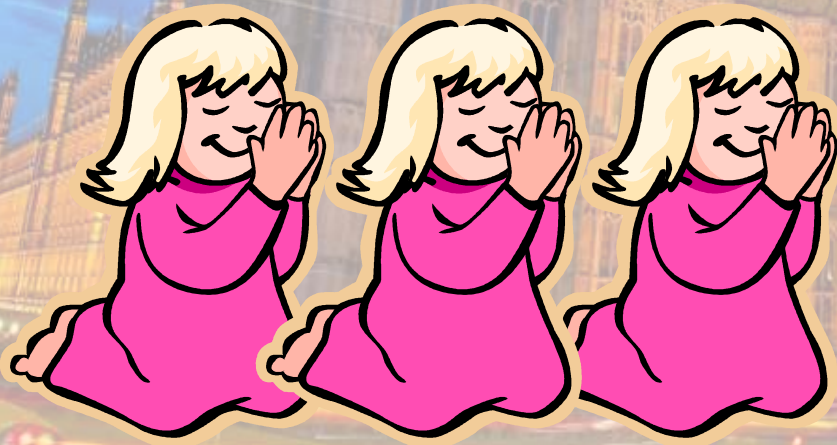

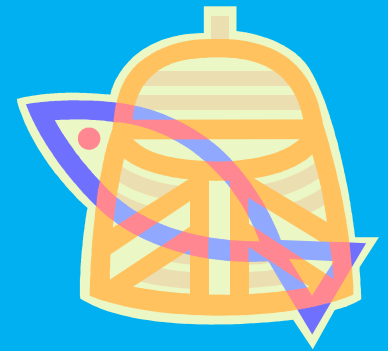
