## Painesville's New Water Intake Opens

On Wednesday, September 30, the City of Painesville held a small grand opening ceremony for the Painesville Water Plant's new 4,000-foot raw water intake. The \$14 million project, which has been in the works since November 2016, is an example of modern engineering and local collaboration. The new intake broke a U.S. construction record with Ric-Man Construction Inc. achieving the title of the longest microtunneling project in the United States by tunneling 25 feet below the bottom of Lake Erie's shale and clay for a total of almost 4,000-feet for the 60-inch pipe.

The City's old 36-inch, 4,000-foot water intake was originally designed in 1951 and was plagued with problems from the beginning. Due to unforeseen joint and pipe issues, the water plant was only able to pull water 1,500-feet from shore. After years of repairs, the remaining 2,500-feet of pipe and intake crib was abandoned in 1968.

After the harmful algal blooms that plagued Lake Erie's western communities in 2014, the Ohio EPA began offering planning and design loans at 0% interest to encourage development that prevents harmful algal blooms from affecting community water supplies. With this loan, the new water intake project became a reality for the City of Painesville.

In 2014, the City selected Burgess & Niple to prepare plans and specifications for the new water intake. Ric-

Man Construction Inc. was named the primary contractor and construction engineer and inspector, Mannick Smith Group, were all able to work together with water plant staff to resolves design and construction issues throughout the three and half year construction.

"The new intake is essential for the on-going operation of the Painesville Water Treatment Plant because it will take us into the next 100 plus years," said Doug Lewis, Assistant City Manager.

The Painesville Water Plant supplies quality water to approximately 32,000 people in Painesville City, Painesville Township, Grand River, Concord Township and a small section of Mentor. The new intake is projected to help save costs on reduced treatment processes and require less wear and tear on plant equipment, making for a more efficient water treatment process.

"Generally, the further out you are, the cleaner the water," said Orin McMonigle, Painesville Water Superintendent. "Lake

## Snow Reminders

Plowing the roads in Painesville is a full time job. During the winter months, the City works around the clock with two shifts every day. When the snow is heavy, those shifts become 12 hours to keep up with Mother Nature.

- In all, the City of Painesville has seven snow plow trucks in commission, all with salt spreaders. Roads are plowed in order of importance - starting with emergency routes, busy roads, hills and bridges. Once those roads are cleared, the secondary streets are plowed.

- There is an automatic parking ban when two inches of snow falls within 24 hours.

- Keep your snow on your own property! Plowing into the street is dangerous for other drivers and doubles our plow drivers' workload when they are trying to keep the streets safe.

- While the City plows the streets, it's the property owner's responsibility to shovel snow on any sidewalk abutting their property. In general, sidewalks should be shoveled within 24 hours after the final snowfall. Remember, most of our students walk to and from school everyday!

- Make sure you keep fire hydrants unblocked. It's the property owner's responsibility to keep them uncovered. This allows our Fire Department to quickly and effectively access water in case of an emergency, saving precious time.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding plowing, please contact the Public Works office at 440-392-9676. Remember, during winter storms, crew members will be out plowing and you may have to leave a message.

# Smart Meters for Painesville Electric Customers

Painesville Electric is pleased to announce plans to upgrade the electric meters in your neighborhood. This upgrade will begin late October and will take approximately six months to complete. We are excited about bringing advanced technology to our community and the benefits

it will provide our customers, that's why we want to keep you informed and answer any questions you may have.

Our current meter infrastructure is being replaced by advanced meters capable of providing more accurate and timely data to us and you, the customer. This new

meter transmits the data to us over a secure wireless network that is being installed in Painesville. Unlike the current analog meters, advanced meters or 'smart' meters, do not need to be read by a meter reader and provides two-way communication for improved efficiencies, distribution automation and improved power

quality and reliability.

Investment in a solid Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) helps us improve the way we do business and allows our customers to take control over their energy usage. Because these meters are digital and use a wireless network for two-way communication, usage data is more timely, accurate and secure. Because we are receiving usage data over a wireless network, we no longer need to drive or enter a customer's property to obtain electric readings.

We estimate it will take approximately 5 minutes to replace the typical electric meter. In order to do the work safely, your electric service will be turned off during this time while the work

is being done. As long as a meter technician can access your meter, you do not have to be present. We will leave a door hanger notifying you that the work was completed. If we are unable to access the meter, we will leave a door hanger providing you information to re-schedule.

As utility infrastructure across the country ages, it is being replaced with the most advanced technology available, including advanced meters. Through this program, we are able to offer our customers the same host of safe, secure and accurate services as neighboring utilities at no additional cost.

## Laketrans Celebrates 25 Years of Serving Lake County Veterans, Offers Free Rides on Veterans Day

For 25 years, Laketrans has operated a special Veterans Medical Transportation service, Veterans Service Commission in partnership with Lake County and Lake County Board of

Commissioners.

The program guarantees Lake County veterans have access to VA appointments, healthcare and adult daycare centers by providing free door-to-door transportation to veterans and their spouses. Veterans can travel to any medical facility in Lake County and to Louis Stokes Cleveland VA Medical Center, Cleveland Clinic and University Hospitals in University Circle.

The transportation program has grown to provide over 10,000 medical trips annually.

"We have a deep respect and appreciation for the sacrifices our veterans have made," said Ben Capelle, Laketrans CEO. "Laketrans is proud to partner with Lake County Veterans Service Commission and the Lake County Commissioners for the last 25 years to ensure our veterans have accessible transportation to get the care they need."

Veterans must register with the Veterans Service Commission to be eligible for the free transportation.

In addition to its medical transportation, Laketrans will be offering free rides to veterans on Veterans Day, Wednesday, November 11. Dial-a-Ride customers can inform Laketrans of their veteran status when scheduling their reservation.

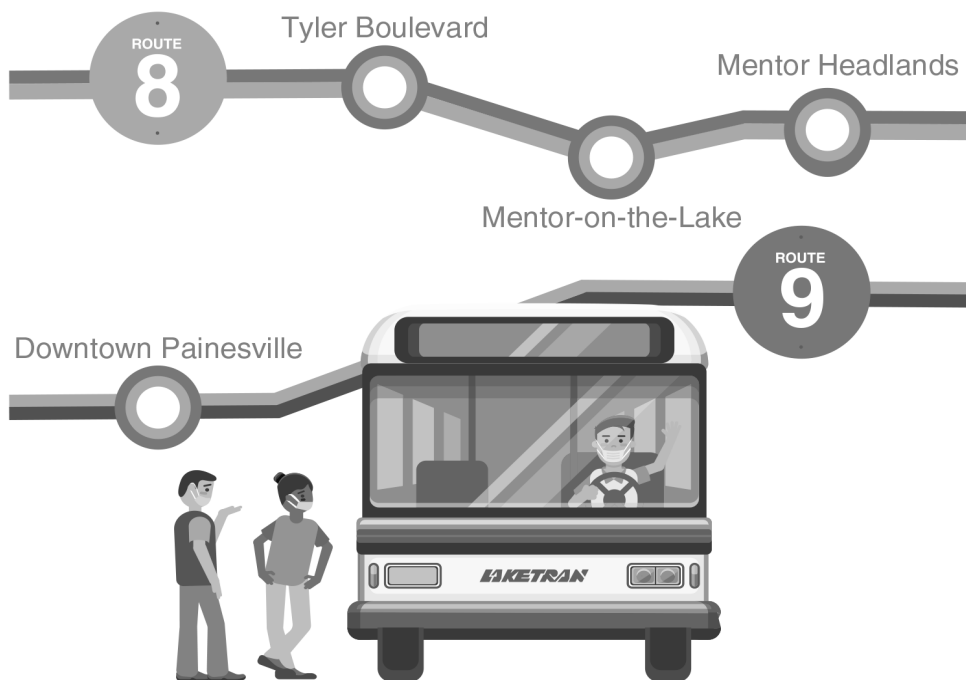

## City Sidewalk Program Continues

As a result of the aging infrastructure and Painesville City Council's goal to "improve Painesville's environment and image," in 2018 City Council passed the Painesville City Sidewalk Program, a two phase improvement plan. The program was designed to benefit residents by improving the aesthetics of owner-occupied single-family homes, thus increasing property values and improving neighborhoods.

During Phase 1 (2018-2020), city staff replaced damaged sidewalk slabs that fell under city responsibility and removed any trees that were deemed hazardous to sidewalks or infrastructure. Phase 2 (2020-2021), has property owners replacing sidewalk slabs that fall under their responsibility and any trees that may be deemed hazardous to those sidewalks. Property owners will receive a letter in the mail if their sidewalks will need to be replaced.

### Replacement Criteria

- Sidewalk slabs that are raised

or settled creating a trip hazard

- Sidewalks with a large number of cracks
- Sidewalk slabs that have a large amount of surface spalling/chipping causing an uneven surface
- Sidewalks that are any material but concrete

After the Sidewalk Program passed, the city applied for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) through the Lake County Commissioners Office and was awarded \$50,000 to fund the Disadvantaged Sidewalk Assistance Program for Painesville residents.

This program is designed to benefit low to moderate income residential homeowners, particularly those who have been cited for sidewalk violations and cannot afford to fix them. ## Please Don't Feed the Deer...

As a friendly reminder, please don't feed the deer in your yard. Although it may seem like an act of kindness, it causes more harm than good:

- Deer spread diseases by carrying ticks that can have Lyme Disease and other infectious diseases.

- Human food is unnatural to them. It takes 2-4 weeks of feeding for deer to even obtain nutrients from our food. The rapid exposure to concentrated grain diet can lead to death. Corn is also not good.

- Habituation to humans leads to increased vehicle collisions and aggressive behavior.

- Long-term habitat destruction

occurs (aka your neighbors' yards).

- Increases risk of deer-to-deer diseases like chronic wasting disease and tuberculosis due to gathering in large numbers.

- 'Feed junkies' behave unnaturally as they lose their natural wariness to humans and odd behavior attracts predators.

- Food attracts other nuisance animals and predators like coyotes. These other animals then become a danger to neighborhood pets like cats and dogs.

Participants should bring binoculars and a spotting scope as these can not be shared outside one's household. Groups on field trips try to maintain distance, but masks are necessary when birders who have spotted a bird are in close proximity to those they are helping to find one.

Presque Isle State Park is a 3,200-acre sandy peninsula that arches into Lake Erie. The road system within the park forms a loop about 13 miles long. It can be reached by PA-832 north from I-90, about a 1½ hour drive from Lake County.

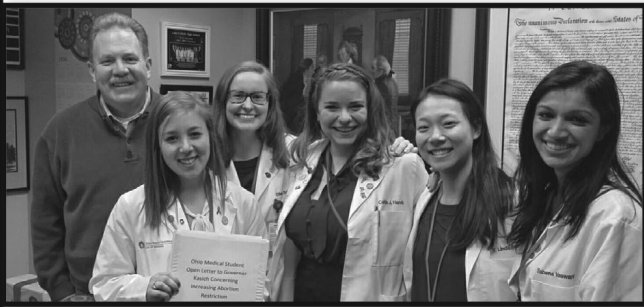

# DIVORCE 101:

*Getting a Divorce Fast, Easy and Cost Effectively*

This article simplistically identifies the main issues in the termination of the marital contract and explains the difference between a divorce and dissolution and why a dissolution is always the best, least stressful and most cost-effective means to terminate the marital contract. The issues in either a dissolution or divorce are the same. They are as follows: (1.) Allocation of Parental Rights and Responsibilities, if there are children. The main issues regarding the allocation of parental rights and responsibilities would include who pays child support and how much, companionship time (formerly "visitation"), who has custody or how is shared parenting (formerly "joint custody") to be allocated, who is responsible for health care/ insurance and how will the tax exemption be divided. (2.) Spousal support. Will one party pay the other spousal support and how much and for how long? (3.) Property distribution. How will the marital real and personal property and all other marital assets be divided. (4.) Pension and retirement division, if in existence. And, finally, (5.) Allocation of marital debt. These are the main issues in every divorce and/or

dissolution.

The most fundamental difference between a contested divorce and a dissolution is that in a contested divorce the parties cannot agree on one or more of the issues whereas in a dissolution the parties must agree on ALL issues. Dissolutions are very cost effective. The cost of the dissolution varies based upon the number of issues in the case (listed above). The cost of a dissolution is dramatically less than a divorce (the parties cannot agree on one or more of the issues). The average cost of a divorce with children in Ohio is \$18,800 and without children \$12,500 (Lawyers.com survey). The average cost of a dissolution with children is \$3500 and without children \$2500. Most importantly, the emotional cost of a prolonged divorce is high to both parties and children.

Dissolutions are fast. A dissolution can be finalized in as little as six-weeks from the filing date and, usually, requires only one hearing. An action for divorce- if the parties cannot come to a voluntary agreement- can easily take a year or longer to finalize. There are several hearings and a trial. The information gathering process referred to as "discovery" can become a costly and stressful nightmare. Discovery

is not required in a dissolution. In divorce, there is the dread of runaway attorney fees averaging \$250- \$300 per hour. There is always the worry (which is justified) that the attorney will quit if you run out of money or the fear of receiving another several thousand-dollar bill unexpectedly. Almost everyone has heard a horror story about attorney fees.

At Biales Delchin Law, dissolution is a flat fee. Our clients don't worry about getting a huge hourly bill after the initial payment.

The emotional price of continuous daily resentment, depression, fear and worry can become overbearing and destructive to one's health. Dissolution avoids all of this. That being said; It is very difficult to get two people who are usually not the best of friends- to begin with- to agree on all issues. All issues must be agreed to for a successful dissolution to occur. This requires compromise. The cardinal rule is that nobody walks away happy.

Each party usually feels wronged in some way by the other. Each party usually feels that they could have obtained a better result if they would have just held out longer or been more aggressive. The truth is the law is pretty settled on how property and children issues are resolved. In most cases, you will not get a better result by engaging in prolonged divorce litigation.

If the parties are unable to come to an agreement regarding all the issues, as is often the case, a divorce must be initiated. I try to resolve as many issues as possible before hand and communicate with the other party or his/her attorney to coordinate the process. It is always best to work together and focus upon resolution of the issues on which the parties agree. The purpose of the attorney is to make the process as minimally painful, and least expensive as possible. Open and honest communication is key. Unfortunately, in many cases, the parties have so much resentment toward each other that

they are simply unable to cooperate. This is never in anybody's best interest and can be very damaging to children.

There are certainly ways to minimize the pain and cost of a divorce, but it will never be as efficient and emotionally healthy as two parties coming to a voluntary agreement with dissolution. I believe that a fast, relatively inexpensive dissolution of marriage with minimal stress and pain to the parties and their children is possible in most cases if two factors are present (1.) the parties are mature, sensitive and intelligent and (2.) the matter is approached with a cost versus benefit business analysis, an open mind and sound professional guidance. I know this is easier said than done. But- if accomplished- the financial and emotional rewards (including healing time) reaped are enormous for the parties and children and will be enjoyed for the span of one's entire life.

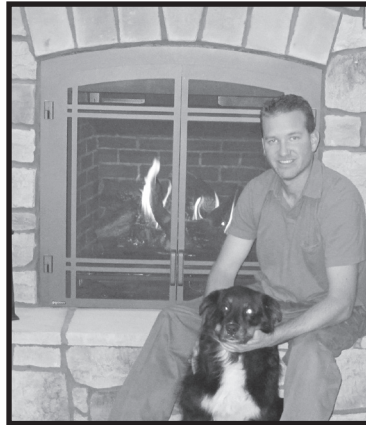

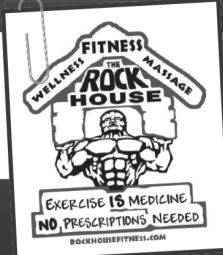

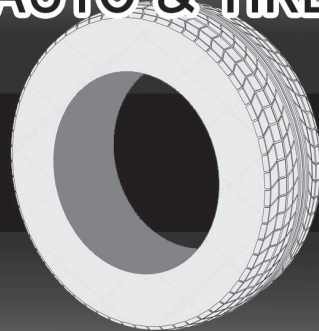
