800 yards of fingering weight yarn (600 yards of color A, 200 yards of color B)

MEASUREMENTS
$15^{\prime \prime}$ wide and $72^{\prime \prime}$ long

NEEDLES + NOTIONS
US 5 24" circulars
US 6 24" circulars
6 stitch markers

## GAUGE

4.5 sts per inch on smaller needles in garter stitch after blocking

## ABBREVIATIONS

k - knit
k2tog - knit 2 together
p-purl
pm - place marker
RS - right side
s2kp2 - slip 2, knit 1, pass 2
sm - slip marker
ssk - slip slip knit
st(s) - stitch(es)
WS - wrong side
yo - yarn over

## NOTES

Use the Diamond Mosaic (back page) and Zig Zag Lace (opposite) patterns between garter stitch sections (opposite) in any combination.

## CAST ON

1. With larger needles, cast on 68 sts.
2. Switch to smaller needles and knit two rows.
3. (RS) K1, (yo, k2tog) to last st, k1.
4. (WS) K4, pm, $k$ to last 4 sts, $\mathrm{pm}, \mathrm{k} 4$.

## CAST OFF

Remove all markers.

1. K1, (yo, k2tog) to last st, k1.
2. Knit 3 rows.
3. With larger needles, bind off all stitches.
4. Weave in ends and block.

## GARTER PATTERN

1. $\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{yo}, \mathrm{k} 2 \mathrm{tog}, \mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{sm}, \mathrm{k}$ to m, sm, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
2. Knit one row.
3. Repeat steps $1 \& 2$ for pattern.

## ZIG ZAG LACE PATTERN

Follow chart below (knitting all WS rows) or written
instructions:

1. $K 1$, yo, $k 2$ tog, $k 1$, (k1, yo, ssk, k7, k2tog, yo) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
2. Knit one row.
3. K1, yo, k2tog, k1, (k2, yo, ssk, k5, k2tog, yo, k1) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
4. Knit one row.
5. K1, yo, k2tog, k1, (k1, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
6. Knit one row.
7. K1, yo, k2tog, k1, (k2, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k1) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
8. Knit one row.
9. $\mathrm{K} 1, \mathrm{yo}, \mathrm{k} 2 \mathrm{tog}, \mathrm{k} 1$, (k1, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, yo, s2kp2, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
10. Knit one row.
11. K1, yo, k2tog, k1, (k2, yo, ssk, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k1) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
12. Knit one row.
13. K1, yo, k2tog, k1, (k3, yo, ssk, yo, s2kp2, yo, k2tog, yo, k2) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
14. Knit one row.
15. K1, yo, k2tog, k1, (k4, yo, ssk, k1, yo, k2tog, k3) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
16. Knit one row.
17. K1, yo, k2tog, k1, (k5, yo, s2kp2, yo, k4) to last m, k1, ssk, yo, k1.
18. Knit one row.
19. Repeat steps 1-18 for pattern.

As indicated to the right of the chart, work two rows (one RS and one WS) with each color, starting with color B.

All WS rows are worked the same as the previous row but in reverse (knit the knit stitches and slip the slip stitches).
