

## DRIVER EDUCATION CLASS CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT

*Students participating in Driver Education program through JDS Carolinas, Inc. must adhere to the Code of Student Conduct identified in the Student/Parent Handbook. Private school students must adhere to rules and regulations as required by the host school. In addition to the COSC, the following requirements must be met:*

1. Students MUST make up time and all work resulting in absence during make-up dates as determined by instructor and site coordinator.
2. Students who miss more than one (1) session of a three (3) hour a day class or two (2) sessions of a two (2) hour a day class will be dropped from the roll.
3. The classroom phase must be successfully completed with a final grade of seventy (70) or above.
4. Cheating is grounds for dismissal from the Driver Education Program.
5. Disrespect to instructors and fellow students and continued disruption of classroom (talking, noises, etc.) are grounds for dismissal.
6. Students must arrange transportation to and from class. Students must be picked up within fifteen (15) minutes after the scheduled ending time of Driver Education.
7. Students will be charged for lost and damaged textbooks. Students will not be scheduled for behind-the-wheel instruction until damaged fees are paid.
8. Students are only allowed in designated areas of the school facility. Anyone caught in off-limit areas will be dropped from the program.
9. Students who fail or who are dismissed from class due to behavior or attendance issues must contract with a private driver education school and pay to retake the program.
10. **NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PERMITTED in class. ALL devices must be POWERED OFF COMPLETELY but may be used during break time(s). Any student violating this rule (by text-messaging, etc.) will be dismissed IMMEDIATELY from that day's class, thus, falling short of state-required hours. A second violation will result in PERMANENT DISMISSAL from the Driver Education Class.**
11. NO STUDENT will be scheduled for behind-the-wheel instruction unless all thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction has been completed as required by law.
12. JDS Carolinas strives to complete the driving phase for students within a reasonable amount of time (within 10-12 weeks after last day of classroom instruction). Parent / Guardian will receive a phone call from the instructor to schedule behind-the-wheel hours.
