Nevada was +39 ATS points vs Colorado St in a 52-10 win (-3).
 The Buffalo/Ball St game went UNDER the total by 36.5 points!
 The Charlotte/Old Dominion game went OVER the total by 34.5 points!
 Michigan is 10-2 ATS this year covering their games by an average of 9.5 ppg
 New Mexico is 1-11 ATS this year failing to cover by an average of 6.8 ppg!
 The OVER is 9-3 in Rice games going OVER by an average of 6.3 ppg!
 The UNDER is 9-2-1 in Boise St games going UNDER by an average of 8.0 ppg!

Misleading Finals

Nevada crushed Colorado St 52-10. However, Nevada only had a 528-443 yard edge as they were +5 in TO's.

Memphis beat Tulane 33-28. However, Tulane had a 452-412 yard edge but the Green Wave were -4 in TO's.

Middle Tennessee upset FAU 27-17. However, FAU had a 413-363 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. FAU led 17-10 entering the 4Q.

UAB beat UTEP 42-25. However, UAB only had a 328-303 yard edge as they were +2 in TO's. UAB only led 28-25 entering the 4Q.

UCF beat USF 17-13. However, USF had a 312-285 yard edge. USF got stopped inside the UCF 10-yard line in the final seconds.

Bad Beats

North Carolina Money-line and UNDER 61.5 bettors got a bad beat last Friday. North Carolina led 30-21 after making a 50-yard FG with 2:12 left in the game. NC State got a 64-yard TD with 1:35 left. Then the Wolf Pack recovered the onside kick. Instead of lining up for a FG, NC State got a 24-yard TD pass to put the game OVER the total with a 34-30 win.

Tennessee (-18.5) first half bettors got the worst beat of the weekend. The Vols led 24-0. Vanderbilt got a 56-yard "Hail Mary" TD pass on the final play of the half.

Injuries/Personnel News

Fresno St QB Jake Haener is transferring to Washington. He won't play in the bowl game. Keep that in mind when the bowl lines open up next Sunday.

Purdue QB Jack Plummer is in the transfer portal. Plummer won the starting job entering 2021 but was replaced as the No. 1 QB after four games by Aidan O'Connell. Five Auburn players are in the transfer portal including RB Shaun Shivers, OL Tashawn Manning and WR Elijah Canion. The program parted ways with offensive coordinator Mike Bobo after one year Monday. DB Ladarius Tennison and DE Caleb Johnson are the two defenders in the portal.

Oklahoma QB Spencer Rattler is in the transfer portal.

UCF QB Dillon Gabriel is in the transfer portal.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Friday, December 3rd

CUSA Championship Game - Alamodome - San Antonio, TX

Western Kentucky 38 UTSA 35. These two played earlier this year on October 9th with UTSA winning outright 52-46 as 3.5-point road underdogs. WKU did have a 670-564 yard edge in the game. WKU has won 7 straight games since by an average of 26.4 ppg going 6-1 ATS covering by an average of 12.4 ppg. Meanwhile, UTSA, despite a 11-1 straight up record, has failed to cover in their last 3 games including getting crushed by North Texas 45-23 last week (we won on these pages fading them). WKU's QB Bailey Zappe has a 52-to-9 TD-to-INT ratio this year! We bet WKU as an underdog on the Sunday openers and obviously there has been some value lost. We still lean that way. One thing we will mention for UTSA as there last couple of home crowds have caused disruption for the opposing teams with multiple false start penalties.

Pac-12 Championship Game - Allegiant Stadium - Las Vegas, NV

† **Utah 31 Oregon 30.** These two just played on November 20th with Utah winning 38-7 as 3-point home favorites over a then No. 3 Oregon team. We bet 14/1 to win the Pac-12 in the summer. It didn't look good early when they started with a couple losses to BYU and San Diego St in non-conference action. However, with Cam Rising at QB, the Utes won 8 of their last 9 games. Outside of the win in Columbus in Week 2, we haven't been overly impressed with the Ducks this year. However, we expect a much better effort out of them here than what we saw in Salt Lake. We bet them +3.5 on the Sunday openers.

Saturday, December 4th

Big 12 Championship Game - AT&T Stadium - Arlington, TX

† **Oklahoma St 26 Baylor 21.** Oklahoma St is not only playing for a Big 12 Championship but a Georgia win over Alabama and a win by the Pokes here (or a Michigan/Cincinnati loss) would put them in the CFB playoffs. Since a shaky start, the Pokes are on a 9-0-1 ATS run. The push was in last week's game vs arch rival Oklahoma. These two did meet on October 2nd with Oklahoma St getting a 24-14 win as a 4-point home favorite (OSU 400-274 yard edge). It should be noted Oklahoma St won and covered that game despite being -3 in TO's. The biggest question mark for this game revolves around the health status of Baylor QB Gerry Bohanon who has missed the last 6 quarters due to a hamstring. His status is uncertain. Blake Shapen has filled in nicely. We bet Baylor +6.5 on the Sunday opener. Was it our favorite bet we made that day? No. However, our numbers said there was some value on Baylor (market has agreed with us so far). We expect Bohanon to play. Most importantly, Oklahoma St is playing with playoff pressure off a huge win over their rival.

MAC Championship Game - Ford Field - Detroit, MI

† **Kent St 38 Northern Illinois 35.** Another championship game with a rematch. Kent St beat Northern Illinois 52-47 on November 3rd as 3.5-point favorites. Kent St had a 682-663 yard edge and were +1 in TO's. Both teams excelled in close games this year with Kent St 4-0 in games decided by a TD or less. Meanwhile, Northern Illinois was 7-2 in one possession games. The Huskies were out-gained on the season and have given up at least 222 rush yards in each of their last 4 games including 360 to Kent St. We bet Kent St -2 on the openers. One thing worth noting is that NIU's 21-point loss to Western Michigan is a bad data point as they rested QB Rocky Lombardi. He should be back for this game for NIU.

Sun Belt Championship Game - Cajun Field, Lafayette, LA

Appalachian St 28 UL-LAFAYETTE 26. These two met back on October 12th and ULL crushed the Mountaineers 41-13 as 4.5-point home underdogs. ULL had a 455-211 yard edge. It was by far ULL's best performance of the season. The Cajuns have won 11 straight games but are only 5-7 ATS on the season and we've actually downgraded them in our power ratings in that span. Meanwhile, App St is on a 5-1 ATS run since that loss to ULL and their only non-cover came by a 0.5-point last week to Georgia Southern. This will be the final game for ULL head coach Billy Napier who was hired by Florida this week. Will the ULL players be inspired or are there too many distractions? Against common opponents, App St is +22 ppg and +108 ypg while ULL is +9 ppg and +33 ypg. We bet Appalachian St -2 on the openers but we were thinking Napier wasn't going to coach this one at the time. Now it's a pass especially at -3.

AAC Championship Game - Nippert Stadium, Cincinnati, OH

CINCINNATI 33 Houston 20. Our numbers like Cincinnati in this match-up and we bet Cincy -10 on the openers. Houston has won 11 straight games, but who in the heck have the Cougars played? How about ZERO teams in the top 50 of our power ratings. Cincinnati is playing

with playoff pressure knowing that a win here likely makes them the first Group of 5 team to ever make it. That's a concern but Cincy has stepped up the last two weeks vs a pair of bowl teams and smashed SMU and ECU, two teams Houston was fortunate to win against. One thing that could be a hidden factor is the crowd. Houston will be playing in front of a raucous crowd for the first time in a couple years (we don't count the neutral site vs Texas Tech). Cincy beat Houston 38-23 (-7) and 38-10 (-13) the last two years. You have the same head coaches and the same starting QB's as each of those. What has changed?

SEC Championship Game - Mercedes-Benz Stadium - Atlanta, GA

† **Georgia 26 Alabama 21.** Obviously, the game of the year in CFB so far. This is Alabama's largest underdog role since the 2008 SEC Championship (+10 vs then No. 1 Florida and Tim Tebow). For those counting, that's 180 games ago! It is only the 2nd time the Crimson Tide have been an underdog since the 2009 SEC Championship game (2015 at Georgia) a game Alabama won 38-10. In fact, Alabama has won 6 straight over Georgia since 2008. Clearly, Georgia has the edge at the line of scrimmage. The Bulldogs' defense is one of the best in CFB history. They are the first defense to hold every opponent to 17 points or less since Texas did it in 1979! Alabama has really struggled on the offensive side with LSU and Auburn in recent weeks severely limiting the Crimson Tide's rush attack. However, Alabama has the edge at QB and head coach. We did bet Georgia -3 when they opened this line up a couple weeks ago. However, at the current number we lean with Alabama.

ACC Championship Game - Bank of America Stadium - Charlotte, NC

† **2★ Pittsburgh 38 Wake Forest 32.** Raise your hand if you had these two playing in the ACC Championship game? Pitt was 60/1 to win the ACC in the preseason while Wake was 100/1. Both teams are 10-2 straight up but Pitt has been more impressive at 9-3 ATS this season with an average cover of 7.3 ppg. Wake is just 6-6 ATS. Both teams have explosive offenses with Pitt averaging 513 ypg and 43 ppg while Wake averages 484 ypg and 43 ppg. The major difference here is on the defensive side of the ball. Wake allows 29 ppg and 428 ypg. Pittsburgh allows just 353 ypg and 23 ppg. Both of Wake Forest's losses this year (Clemson and North Carolina) were teams that Pitt beat this year. Also noteworthy is Clemson's defense sacking Wake QB Sam Hartman 7 times a couple weeks ago. Pitt's defense is actually better at getting after the QB than Clemson with 46 sacks on the season! The only concern here is that Wake head coach Dave Clawson is a superior coach to Pat Narduzzi. Still, this is our favorite play of the week right now.

Big Ten Championship Game - Lucas Oil Stadium - Indianapolis, IN

† **Michigan 27 Iowa 18.** Alright, raise your hand if you had this match-up even last week? Iowa pulled the small upset over Nebraska (Hawkeyes trailed 21-6 at one point) and needed Wisconsin to lose as TD-favorites to Minnesota. Meanwhile, Michigan upset their arch rival Ohio St for the first time in a decade with an impressive 42-27 win as 6.5-point home underdogs. Obviously, Michigan's defense has a huge edge vs Iowa's offense. You wouldn't think letdown here for the Wolverines with the CFB Playoff on the line but did you see the emotion after that win last week? Iowa is an overrated 10-2 team as they've been outgained on the season (-17 ypg). Still, they play great defense and take care of the football (+13 TO's). We believe that's the recipe here to keep it under the 10.5-point spread. The last two times these teams have met...Iowa won 16-13 in 2016 and only lost 10-3 in 2019.

Mountain West Championship Game - Health Sports Park - Carson, CA

SAN DIEGO ST 28 Utah St 22. Utah St's Blake Anderson did a tremendous job in year one getting the Aggies to this game. They were 50/1 to win the conference and their season win total was only 3.5! They have a high-powered offense led by QB Bonner and WR Thompkins but defensively San Diego St is far superior. Look at the teams Utah St lost to this year (Boise St, BYU, Wyoming). They're all big and physical at the line of scrimmage which is exactly what San Diego St is. Utah St was fortunate to avoid Fresno St, Nevada and San Diego St this year in cross-division play. San Diego St has a chance for a school-record 12th win in a season. We bet San Diego St -4 on the openers but wouldn't lay the -6 now.

CALIFORNIA 30 USC 26. This was the only FBS game that was postponed this year due to COVID! Cal was such a disappointment for us on these pages last week. Maybe you didn't watch it because of the late West Coast kickoff but Cal (+6.5) led 14-10 late 2Q. After that...UCLA scored 32 consecutive points! Meanwhile, USC put forth a good effort in a 35-31 loss to BYU (USC's first cover in 6 games). Both teams will be at home for the holidays. Do the USC's players get a bump with the Lincoln Riley news? We bet numbers and took Cal -2 on the openers but wouldn't play it now. It is worth noting that USC is on a 15-1 straight up run in the series.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, December 2nd

Dallas 25 NEW ORLEANS 21. Both of these teams are playing back-to-back Thursdays after losing on Thanksgiving last week. Both teams are reeling with Dallas losing 3 of their last 4 and the Saints losing each of their last 4. The 6 points scored by the Saints last week was tied for the fewest ever under Sean Payton. The Saints are going to make the switch to Taysom Hill at QB. Meanwhile, Mike McCarthy is out for the Cowboys (COVID). Tough game to bet and handicap.

Sunday, December 5th

Minnesota 25 DETROIT 19. The Vikings came up short last week on these pages as a couple of costly TO's did them in. RB Dalvin Cook was also lost due to a shoulder injury. Meanwhile, the Lions come in at 0-10-1 but have covered in 7 games and have lost 3 times on the final play including last week to Chicago. Chicago did have a 378-239 yard edge. One of those final play losses came at Minnesota earlier this year as the Vikings hit a 54-yard FG on the final play to win 19-17. That's 7 straight wins for the Vikings in this series. Make it 8. But we're not laying a TD on the road. We will take the UNDER.

Arizona 25 CHICAGO 17. While it has not been officially announced, Kyler Murray looks to return here for the Cardinals after the bye. The fact that Arizona is laying more than a TD on the road is telling you that. Even without Murray, the Cardinals went 2-1 pulling a couple of outright upsets. The Bears come in off the last-second win over the Lions on Thanksgiving. Early forecast calls for 40 degrees, rain and wind. We'll lean UNDER and Zona in a teaser.

3★ Atlanta (plus the points) Tampa Bay 30 ATLANTA 21. Tampa Bay backers were fortunate to get the cover last week in their 38-31 come-from-behind win. Leonard Fortunato, we mean Fournette scored a late TD. Tampa benefited from 5 Indianapolis TO's. Meanwhile, Atlanta picked up a road win at Jacksonville thanks to a now-healthy Cordarrelle Patterson. He's could be a difference-maker for them on offense. The Falcons have been terrible at home this year at 0-4 and are only 14-22 at home in their new stadium since 2017. Still, this line seems a bit pricey for a Tampa team making their 4th road trip in 5 games. We like Atlanta.

KANSAS CITY 28 Denver 18. This game was flexed to Sunday Night Football. KC comes in off the bye. Prior to it, the Chiefs had some momentum winning 4 straight games to take over 1st place in the AFC West. They have dominated this series with 11 wins in a row (9-2 ATS). However, the Chiefs are on a 1-9 ATS run at home. Here's yet another trend...Andy Reid off a bye (Philly and KC) is on a 27-6 SU/21-12 ATS run. Denver is off a nice win over the Chargers last week but are out-classed here. We don't see much value. Pass.

Indianapolis 28 BUFFALO 17. Indianapolis is off a tough loss to Tampa Bay where they were done in by 5 TO's (ZERO TO's the previous 3 games). The Colts have rebounded from the 0-3 start but at 6-6, can't afford any slip-ups. Meanwhile, Houston is off a loss at home to the Jets as they were favored in a game for the first time this season. Indianapolis won the earlier meeting 31-3. They should have no problem once again.

Philadelphia 26 N.Y. JETS 18. In their largest favorite role of the season last week, the Eagles lost outright to the Giants. Turnovers were the main culprit as Jalen Hurts threw 3 INT's and the Eagles were -4. Meanwhile, they're catching the Jets off a rare win as they upset the lowly Texans. These two don't face each other often but Philadelphia is on a 11-0 SU run vs the Jets since the early 1970's. More of the same here. We like Philly in a teaser.

CINCINNATI 26 L.A. Chargers 24. Cincinnati crushed the Steelers last week as we unfortunately had Pittsburgh on these pages. The Bengals, after their bye, have looked really impressive. Meanwhile, the Chargers are just 1-5 ATS in their last 6 games and were easily handled by the Broncos last week. Seems like a "Buy Low, Sell High" spot. We lean with the Chargers.

MIAMI 23 N.Y. Giants 18. Mike Glennon will get the start for the Giants. The G-Men come in off a win over Philadelphia and they have covered in 4 of their last 5 games. However, the Dolphins (outside of New England) are the hottest team in the NFL right now with 4 straight wins and 4 straight covers. They have a bye on deck and with a win would be back in the playoff hunt. Remarkable considering a 1-7 start. QB Tua has been fantastic including last week going 27 of 31!

2★ LAS VEGAS 27 Washington 21. Situationally this seems like a good spot for the Raiders. They have extra rest off the thrilling OT win over the Cowboys last Thursday. That could have saved their season after a 0-3 SU/ATS run. Meanwhile, Washington is off a last-second win over Seattle on MNF and traveling across the country to face an unfamiliar opponent. The Raiders are 6-0 this season when Derek Carr passes for at least 300 yards. Washington has the No. 30 pass defense in the NFL.

Baltimore 23 PITTSBURGH 19. The Ravens somehow found a way to win and cover last week vs the Browns despite Lamar Jackson's 4 interceptions! That offense has looked really bad as of late scoring 10, 16 and 16 in the last 3 weeks. Meanwhile, the Steelers are coming off a pathetic showing vs the Bengals last week. They'll be plenty motivated here, but they are a far-cry of what they were even a year ago when they started 11-0. We lean UNDER.

L.A. RAMS 30 Jacksonville 16. Three straight losses and an 0-5 ATS mark in their last 5 games has the Rams reeling coming into this one. Obviously, playing the lowly Jacksonville Jags will help get them back on track but there was a point in the season where many thought the Rams were the best team in the NFL. The "All-In" isn't working out so great. How about Stafford throwing "Pick-Six's" in 3 straight games. Jacksonville's offense is a mess right now averaging just 11.4 ppg the last 5 games. The UNDER has cashed in 6 straight Jacksonville games. That's where our lean is.

San Francisco 23 SEATTLE 21. The 49ers certainly have their season back on track now with 3 straight wins and covers to move to 6-5. The Seahawks season is basically over now at 3-8 SU as they've gone 0-3 SU and 0-3 ATS with the return of QB Russell Wilson. The UNDER is an incredible 9-1-1 in Seattle games this year. Is Wilson going to get any healthier as the season drags on? We lean UNDER.

Monday, December 6th

BUFFALO 23 New England 20. Obviously, the Patriots come in as the hottest team in the NFL with 6 straight wins and 6 straight covers. They lead the division at 8-4 and could really take command with an upset here. Meanwhile, the Bills continue to be one of the highest variance teams in NFL history. There's no in-between for them. Look at there last two games, 41-15 loss to Indianapolis as a 7-point favorite and then another blowout win (all 7 of their wins have come by 15 or more). We expect this one to be the outlier as this goes to the wire. Keep an eye on the weather. Early forecast has 27 degrees, snow and 16 mph wind.
