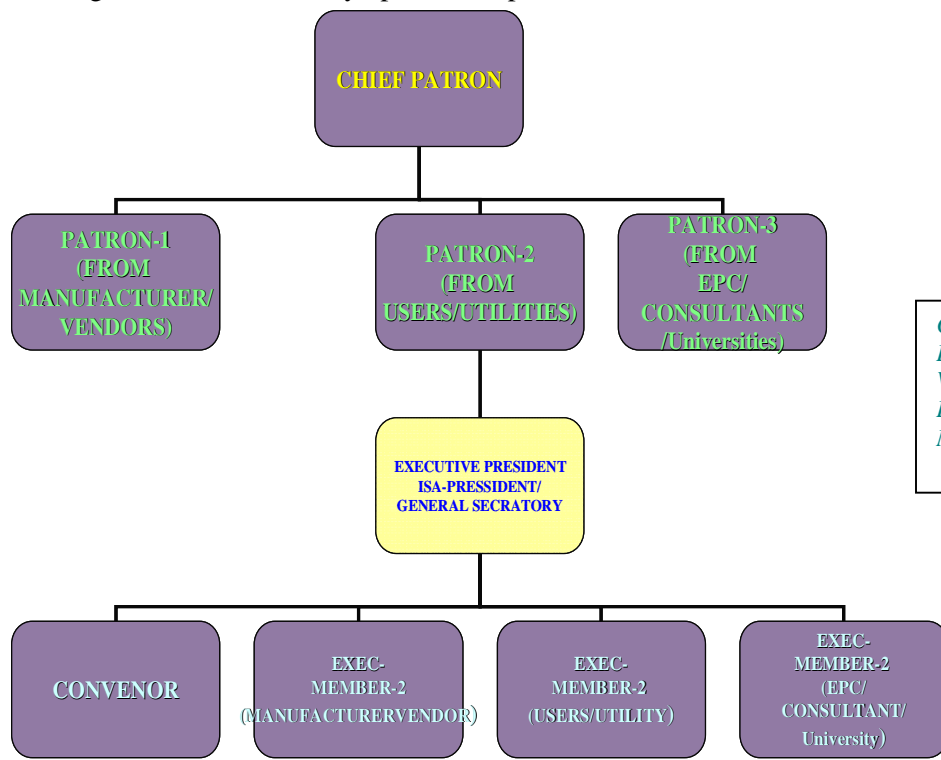


**POWID**
