Our Drop - OFF and Dismissal Procedure

Please take notice of our procedure for our dismissal which we sent to your homes. In order to be in compliance with the State of New Jersey and for the safety of our children the Beginning Bears, 2 1/2's, 3's and "Stars" will be admitted and dismissed from the main RCS entrance and the 4's will be admitted and dismissed from the rear of the building by the backyard. If you have more than one child at RCS and one of your children is in a four year old class your children will be dismissed from the front of the building with the younger ones or "STARS" (unless you ask that. your siblings be dismissed with the older ones in the back with the fours).
