Pleasant Township will not be held liable for non-delivery and/or late delivery of any bid response due to a bidder listing an incorrect address
- 4. The original bid response shall be properly completed, signed by the bidder and accompanied by copy of necessary supportive documentation, including the executed non-collusion affidavit. The original bid response must contain an authorized original signature of the bidder on the signature page.
- 5. Any and all exceptions to the specifications outlined herein shall be noted on the bid specification and thoroughly explained in the bid proposal.
