Entries will be received: Saturday, September 30, 2017, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Sunday, October 1, 2017, between 1 p.m. and 5 p.m., and Monday October 2, 2017 between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Amateur gardeners are encouraged to participate.
2. Exhibits must be registered with the Classification Committee before being placed.
3. **NO ENTRY MAY BE REMOVED BEFORE 5:00 P.M. ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2017, NO EXCEPTIONS.**
4. Exhibitors must provide saucers.
5. Specimens must be correctly named, if possible. Preference will be given to named specimens.
6. All specimens must have been grown by exhibitor.
7. An exhibitor will be allowed only one entry of any one variety in each specimen class.
8. The decision of the judges will be final.
9. The Classification Committee reserves the right to reject specimens not meeting the standards of the show.
10. Please avoid being disqualified by reading the rules of the show and obeying same.
11. **NOTICE:** Specimen plants (house plants) are individual ones that are well cultivated, groomed and displayed in a clean, well proportioned container. They must have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least three months. The same rule applies to hanging baskets.

No Roadside Vegetation: Goldenrod, Dog Fennel, Rabbit Tobacco, etc.

AWARDS

AWARD OF ORNAMENTAL HORTICULTURE EXCELLENCE - The most outstanding exhibit in Horticulture Division. It must score 95 points or more to be eligible. This award is given only to named (Botanical varietal, etc.) exhibits and will have a cash award of \$8.00.

Award of Merit: Classes 1 through 10b are eligible. This award is given to the finest specimen or specimens exhibited in own container and must score 95. The cash value is \$5.00.

Award of Merit: Classes 11 through 16 are eligible. The exhibit must score 95. The cash value is \$5.00.

Award of Merit: Classes 17 through 36 are eligible. The exhibit must score 95. The cash value is \$5.00.

Award of Merit: Classes 37 through 65 are eligible. The exhibit must score 95. The cash value is \$5.00.

Award of Merit: Classes 1 - 16 are eligible. The exhibit must score 95. Choice of Department Superintendent. The cash value is \$5.00.

1st prize - \$2.00

2nd prize - \$1.50

3rd prize - \$1.00 (for specimen plants and hanging baskets ONLY)

SECTION A - SPECIMEN PLANTS (House Plants) - Exhibitors must provide saucers

Class 1 - (a) Saintpaula (African Violet). One specimen, double flowered, (b) Saintpaula (African Violet). One specimen, single flowered.

Class 2 - (a) Begonia (Tuberous-rooted). One specimen - blooming. (b) Begonia (Fibrous-rooted). One specimen - blooming. (c) Begonia (foliage type).

Class 3 - (a) Geranium - flowering. (b) Geranium - Fragrant, Spice, apple or others.

Class 4 - Ferns. One specimen of any variety.

Class 5 - Oriental Pepper Plant. One specimen, any variety.

Class 6 - Succulents.

Class 7 - (a) Flowering Specimens. Unscheduled. (b) Foliage Specimen. Unscheduled.

Class 8 - Orchids

Class 9 - Shamrocks

Class 10 - Vines (a) Flowering (b) Foliage

Class 11 - Mixed Pots

Class 12 - Deco Pot Plants

SECTION B - HANGING BASKETS

Class 11 - Ferns, any variety

Class 12 - Any blooming plants

Class 13 - Any non-blooming plants

Class 14 - Mixed baskets - containing two or more different plants

Class 15 - Hanging plants used as plants on stands rather than as hanging baskets

Class 16 - Spider or Airplane plants

SECTION C - CAMELLIAS

Class 17 - Camellia Japonica - Classified and judged according to variety. Named, if possible

Class 18 - Camellia Sasanqua. Named, if possible.

SECTION D - CHRYSANTHEMUMS

Class 19 - Chrysanthemums - small flowering, 1 spray, classified according to variety.

Class 20 - Chrysanthemums - disbudded, 1 stem (head), classified according to variety

SECTION E - BULBS

Class 21 - Dahlia, any form, large size, over 8 inches. One bloom, classified according to variety

Class 22 - Dahlia, any form, over 4 inches. One bloom, classified according to variety.

Class 23 - Miniature, any form under 4 inches, classified according to variety.

Class 24 - (a) Amaryllis, (b) Caladium, (c) Canna (by variety)

Class 25 - Anemone

Class 26 - Any unscheduled (Iris, Elephant Ear, etc...)

SECTION F - ROSES

Class 27 - Hybrid Tea - One bloom

Class 28 - Grandiflora - One bloom

Class 29 - Floribunda - One lateral spray or cluster.

Class 30 - Floribunda - One bloom

- Class 31** - Polyanthas - One lateral spray or cluster
- Class 32** - Climbers - One stem
- Class 33** - Old Rose (Moss, China, Green Rose, etc) One bloom
- Class 34** -Any variety -One fully opened bloom
- Class 35** - Miniatures - One bloom

- Class 47** - Salvia (a) Red, 1 stem. (b) Blue, 1 stem. (c) Purple, 1 stem. (d) Perennial.
- Class 48** - Zinnia (a) Large, 1 bloom. (b) Small, 3 blooms, one variety.
- Class 49** - Snapdragon, 1 stem
- Class 50** - Strawflower, 1 stem
