- You must be a senior attending any high school in the surrounding area OR enrolled at a university/technical college and under the age of 21 years old as of December 31, 2020.
- Deadline is **April 1st, 2021 at 3:00 pm.**
- The following requirements need to all be in one PDF, to assure we receive everything and have the ability to open it.

The \$500 scholarship award will be issued after you finish the first semester of college and you provide documentation for the completion of the first semester and enrollment in the second semester.

- If you are eligible, you may apply for the scholarship as it is offered, but may only be awarded as the recipient one-time, regardless of continued eligibility..
