**LOCAL POST ELECTIONS.** May is Elections Month in the Legion calendar. Officers will be nominated and elected for Post and District 29 officer positions. In both cases, you can nominate yourself at the General Membership meeting on May 10 for Post 132 and/or May 20 for District 29 which is not uncommon and in no sense unwelcome. Normally, there are too few candidates for posts and your interest in serving will be very welcome. If you are new to serving as a Legion officer and don't want to be overwhelmed, start by serving as an Executive Committee officer, traditionally an entry-level position.

**MEMBERSHIP.** Dues were invoiced months ago and were due no later than Jan. 1. If paid by Feb. 1, membership reinstatement is automatic but if not paid by Feb. 1, you are placed in a suspended status which (per Bylaws Art. XII, sec. 3) means **YOUR POST PRIVILEGES ARE SUSPENDED ON FEBRUARY 1!** If still unpaid on June 30, you are **DROPPED** from Legion membership (Art. XII, sec. 3) & must **REAPPLY** for membership!

**PLEASE DO NOT LET YOUR MEMBERSHIP LAPSE! NO ONE IN THE LEGION & AT THE POST WANTS THAT TO HAPPEN! GET YOUR RENEWAL IN TODAY. Come down to the Post and renew; or contact 1st VC Vic DE LA ROSA (714/227-5977), Cmdr. Jose MARTINEZ (714/380-2005), Finance Off'r Sid GAUNA (714/371-6247), or myself (714/543-9005) & we will process you immediately.**

The delegate strength and influence of Post 132 at the Department of California Annual Convention this summer depends on our paid membership. If you still have not paid for 2018, please, please pay immediately so that we take a prominent position at the Convention.

**HELMETS FOR HEROES.** Post 132 is participating in the Department of California's Helmets for Heroes campaign.
