Highpoint Buckle Series Award Qualifications

Novice All Around Ranch Horse Buckle Award

Novice Ranch Riding: Any rider of any age who has never won a Ranch Riding class in a breed show or a year end championship in any association and never won the CSRHA Open Ranch Riding class. AQHA pattern will be used but may be simplified at the discretion of show management. May show one or two handed in any legal bit or hackamore. Scoring and penalties will be determined using AQHA guidelines.

Green As Grass Reiner: Any rider who has never won a Green Reiner class in CSRHA or NRHA competition. May show one or two handed at any time during the class in any legal bit or hackamore. Simple lead change is allowed. Scoring and penalties will be determined using NRHA guidelines.

Open Ranch Trail: Any age horse shown in a snaffle or legal hackamore may be ridden with one or two hands on the reins. Horses shown in a legal curb bit (AQHA or NRHA) must be ridden one handed. Scoring and penalties will be determined using AQHA guidelines.

Rider must enter all three classes using the same horse (Novice Ranch Riding, Green As Grass Reiner and Open Ranch Trail) on both days of the show (August 12 and 13).

Points will be awarded according to CSRHA rules (1st place = 10 points, 2nd place = 9 points, etc)

All Around Ranch Horse Buckle Award

Open Ranch Riding: Open to riders of any age and any horse. Horses will work individually using AQHA patterns. Must ride 1 handed in any legal curb bit or 2 handed in a snaffle bit or legal hackamore.

Open Trail: Any age horse shown in a snaffle bit or hackamore may be ridden with one or two hands on the reins. Horses shown in any legal curb bit (AQHA or NRHA) must be ridden one handed. Scoring and penalties will be determined using AQHA guidelines.

Green Reiner: Any non pro rider with lifetime earnings of less than \$350 as of January 1 of current year in any reining event. Horse ownership not required. May be ridden 1 or 2 handed at any time during the class in any legal bit or hackamore. Simple lead changes are allowed.

Rider must enter all three classes using the same horse (Open Ranch Riding, Green Reiner and Open Ranch Trail) on both days of the show (August 12 and 13).

Points will be awarded according to CSRHA rules (1st place = 10 points, 2nd place = 9 points, etc)
