

The 2013 convention of The LCMS directed the CTCR, in concurrence with the Office of the President, to update the

1991 edition of Luther's Small Catechism with Explanation (Res. 3-13A), noting "many changes in the understanding of morals, civil law and natural law in church and society." Society-altering changes have occurred in the last 25 years, we have entered an age of computers, smartphones and virtual reality. Today, bullying involves texting as often as physical confrontations; Islam is in the news on a daily basis; and the word "marriage" has taken on a

radically unscriptural meaning. Along the way, Christianity has lost its privileged position, its teachings are often scorned, and Christians are sometimes treated with hostility. Those catechized today are faced with an old question that holds a new sobriety: "Do you intend to continue steadfast in this confession and Church and to suffer all, even death, rather than fall away from it?" Dr. Charles Arand, member of the revision committee, will join us to go over the thought process behind revisions, answer questions about how these revisions effect the classroom, the process going forward with the Catechism, as well as remind us that as Luther saw the absolute need for the Catechism in his day – 500 years later, our need is no less than his.


