Mike Perry sold 200 burgers and 100 hot dogs, Pinky's Ice had a line most of the day making it a great day for all!

We had an *AMAZING* collection of show cars, from old Fire trucks to Don Brock's "new" 1962 Imperial LeBaron to a 1913 Pope Hartford 33 (that was driven, not trailered over 60 miles to the show!).

Our thanks to all our *AMAZING* volunteers that helped set-up, run the show and pack-up! October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month

It's The Journey, Inc. – producer of the Georgia 2-Day Walk for Breast Cancer – is a local organization founded in 2002 by breast cancer survivor Randi Passoff. When the Avon 3-Day Breast Cancer Walk pulled out of Atlanta, Randi, a long-time walker, decided that Atlanta needed a fundraising event where all of the funds stayed local to support Georgia breast cancer patients and breast health programs. The mission of It's The Journey is to raise money to support Georgia breast health and breast cancer programs that focus on education, screening, diagnostics, support services, genetic counseling and testing, research, and serving the unmet needs of the Georgia breast cancer community.

With the generous and dedicated support of donors, participants, and volunteers, It's the Journey has been able to raise \$16.5 million and give 431 grants for vital breast health services in over 100 counties.

Twenty-five Georgia breast health and breast cancer programs received funding raised from the 2020 Georgia 2-Day Walk for Breast Cancer including the Athens Nurses Clinic, Atlanta Cancer Care Foundation, Center for Black Women's Wellness, East GA Cancer Coalition, Good News Clinic (Gainesville), Hope for the Journey, Lighthouse Lymphedema Network, Mercy Care Foundation, Piedmont Hospital (multiple locations), SE Georgia Rural Community Network, The Cancer Foundation, United in Pink and the Wellstar Foundation.
