The following requirements must be met in order to be eligible for the Moose "Heart of the Community" Scholarship Program.

## The applicant must:

- Be a student of the high school graduating Class of 2018 (to be verified by a high school official.)
- Have a father, mother, step-parent, grandparent or legal guardian who is a current member of the Moose in good standing (Applicant is NOT required to reside in the same household).
- Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale or equivalent (proof must be provided via a copy of high school transcript or most recent report card.)
- ✓ The applicant must also have participated in:

In-School / Extra-Curricular activities (i.e. school sports teams, band, chess club, theater, etc.)

- ■To satisfy this requirement a school official must verify this by completing their section of the application.
- Out-of-School activities (i.e. employment, scouting programs, music lessons, non-school related sports)
  - To satisfy this requirement Moose International's Membership department must receive a letter or email from the student's supervising adult (boss, troop leader, etc.) no later than June 30, 2017. The letter should include: 1) The name, title, email, and phone number of the supervising adult; 2) Details of the student's participation; 3) The type of activities they engaged in; and, 4) The dates/date range of their participation.
- Volunteer on behalf of a fraternal unit of the Moose (to be verified by Lodge Administrator, Chapter Recorder or Moose Legion Secretary on the application or by email, fax or U.S. mail.)
