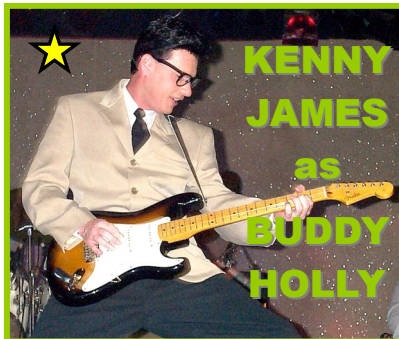

Takacs's Training Tips

The holiday season is upon us and this can be a very stressful time for your dog. Especially during busy gatherings with family and friends. The following are some things you can do to make sure your furry friend has an enjoyable time too.

GET SOME EXERCISE: Prior to your guests coming over you should take your dog for a nice long energetic walk that burns off any excess energy. It will help your dog to be in a nice relaxed state when your guests arrive.

PARTY TIME IS DINNERTIME: Try to set up your dog to be ready for one of his meals when your event is about to begin. Having your dog eat a frozen mixture of his favorite foods and treats stuffed in a Kong toy is a great way to do this.

A SAFE PLACE: If your dog likes to go to his crate or has a favorite room he likes to go to make sure he has access to those places so he can take himself away from the busy activity. Make sure he also has access to his favorite toys or treats in those places.

LET THE DOG COME TO YOU: This is always the best rule of thumb anytime your dog is around other people. Make sure that children are not left unattended with your dog. You will also want to make sure that children know not to make quick movements, stare at the dog in the eyes or hang on or corner the dog. This can greatly reduce the chance for a biting incident at your event.

An "owner surrender" -- RIPLEY -- was fostered by HSNI board member Viktoria Voller, then placed with a lovely couple, Lesley and Randy. in North Carolina.

The range of emotions evoked by your recent gift of one large, furry, brown animal can't be easily described in words but I'll try.

After life with two perfect yet very different dogs, I wasn't sure what could come next. **Cocoa** and **Karma** accompanied Randy and I through 16 years of love, anticipation, commutes, joy, grief, sadness, laughter, holidays, travels, relocations, injuries, sickness, and only one or two uneventful days. Thank you for caring for her until we got there. Thank you for entrusting her to us, and thank you for all the other animals you work so diligently and with so much love to find forever homes. There's a New "MARSHALL" in Town

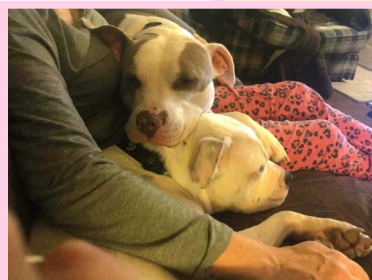
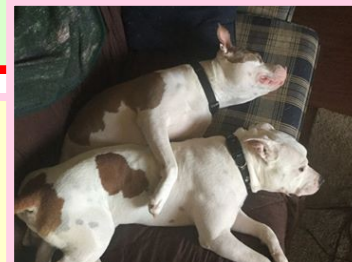
