- Please read our mission statement and the other guidelines to see if your organization is a good match with the Holland Foundation.
- We will ask some preliminary questions, and if we think your organization is a good fit
  with the Holland Foundation's mission and goals, we will send the contact person an
  application link.
- We will not meet with grant seekers before an application is submitted.
- After you have submitted an application, we may ask to meet with you if we need more
  information, or if we want to see your facility, for example. We may not need to meet
  with you.
- Please do not approach individual members of the board unless you have a personal relationship with them.
- Our geographic focus is Nebraska.
- · We do not support religious organizations for religious purposes.
- We may access your most recent Form 990.
- The deadline for applications this year (2017) is July 31<sup>st</sup>.
- The Board of Directors will meet mid-October, and you will be notified soon after that as to the Board's decision.
