DISCUSSION

1. PATRICIA JOHNSON/VANESSA CUNNINGHAM: Mrs. Johnson ask why the fishing tournament at the recreation department was not advertise in the paper, Mr. Hall replied I will check in to this. I have safety concerns about the pond; I will talk to the director. Why the board hired a Chief Code Enforcement Officer, Mr. Long replied because the heavy load of work in the county. Steve is not a Chief Code Enforcement Officer; he does not have the training that position requires. We would like to know about the \$600, 000.00, Mr. Hall stated because of the E-911 and the increase in the EMS contract. Mrs. Johnson ask about the price for copies, Mr. Swindell will check this for us.
2. ROBERT WALKER: Mr. Walker stated that some people are saying we were broke May 15, 2013, this is not true. Mr. Walker told the board that they will have to deal with the EMS bids. The price for the E-911 of 50% is too much for Long County to pay. Mr. Walker discussed about being in the paper about family members having cell phones. The board stated the cell phone bills have been cut in half. The board ask Mr. Walker if he gave permission for Miracle Ranch to locate off of Stafford Dairy Road, he replied no.
3. DEPOT: Mr. Price Chapman discussed about setting up a meeting concerning the depot.
4. ALICE AND BILLY WOODWARD: Mrs. Woodward stated I live at Crawford Division off of DeLoach Road. Mr. Hall stated that I have done some research, the DeLoach Road is county maintained. The Road Department Supervisor will be notified to repair this road.
5. JOHN BRADLEY, CHIEF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER: Mr. Bradley presented his report to the board.

6. ORDINANCE: GOVERNING DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS IN LONG COUNTY: Sheriff Nobles discussed this ordinance with the public. This will be considered the 1st reading.
7. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: We are still working on the Townsend Bombing Range issues, the Tax Commissioner will soon be back in her office, cleaning up around the courthouse and doing an audit on lights to see if this can be a savings to Long County. We had to cut some meals at the Senior Center. We have a prospect that has inquired about locating in the industrial park.
