GIVE TO YARD SALE APPLICATE

DISPLAY OF PERMIT

A yard sale permit shall be prominently displayed on the premises upon which the yard sale is conducted throughout the entire period of the sale.

SIGNS

All signs advertising a yard sale shall include the name and address of the person to whom the permit has been issued. No signs for advertising are to be posted on any place other than the premises of the applicant. The sign shall not exceed four square feet in size and shall not be placed on the premises earlier than one week prior to the sale and shall be removed within twenty-four hours after the sale has terminated.

Posting of signs on property, poles or trees belonging to someone else shall constitute a violation of this section.


HOURS

All yard sales shall be conducted between the hours of 9:00am and 6:00pm only with the further limitation that yard sales on Sunday may not begin before 1:00pm.

PROPERTY OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

All persons shall obey the reasonable orders of any member of the Police or Fire Department of the Borough in order to maintain the public health, safety and welfare.

New Jersey Law and Borough ordinance prohibits the placing of any signs on telephone poles.
