Summary of JOEL ANDERSON's article in the San Diego Union-Tribune March 11, 2017

Sanctuary state bill -SB54 protects felons from being deported

In 2013, the California Legislature passed The TRUST Act, which prohibits state and local law enforcement from complying with requests from federal immigration enforcement to detain prisoners so they may be transferred for deportation proceedings. The TRUST Act does not apply, however, to people convicted of serious felonies.

If San Diego's law enforcement officers encounter everyday people in schools, hospitals or our neighborhoods, they are not arrested for suspected immigration violations. However, they do provide ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement) with access to felons incarcerated in their jails such as rapists, child molesters and arsonists so they can be deported.

SB 54 abandons that position by shielding rapists, child molesters and arsonists from ICE and guaranteeing their return to our neighborhoods.

Over 11,600 felons in our prisons alone (8 percent of prison population) have been identified by ICE as eligible for deportation. That number doesn't include those incarcerated in county and city jails. If SB 54 becomes law, ICE will have no way to find out the release dates, addresses or any other information that can help the agency identify a serious felon it is seeking. To be clear, these are not Dreamers who were pulled over for a broken taillight or expired registration tags. These are felons, who would complete

Expanding California's sanctuary policies to include serious felons will not put an end to federal immigration enforcement. Without an information exchange from local law enforcement, ICE will be obligated to carry out their duty to apprehend those identified as the greatest threat to our public safety by combing through our neighborhoods.

Supporters of SB 54 argue that the bill's provision to require ICE to get a warrant to assume custody of a prisoner will ensure due process for the felon. But that's a near-impossible standard to meet because a federal warrant can only be issued for federal crimes, not state crimes. Rapists and child molesters were convicted under state laws in the majority of cases. Most of the incarcerated that ICE would be looking to deport do not have any federal charges. They rely on immigration hold and notification requests in order to pick up the serious criminals that SB 54 would return to our neighborhoods.

Six of Ten WORST Cities That Protect Criminal Illegal Aliens Are in California By: Steve Frank

"Sanctuary city proponents often say their policies limiting cooperation with federal immigration authorities don't endanger public safety. As ICE's latest weekly declined detainer report shows, however, <u>many county and city law enforcement agencies regularly release criminal aliens who have been convicted of violent crimes, including domestic battery and sexual assault.</u>

In the whole nation, six of the ten worst offenders are in California—anybody surprised? Think Sandra Duran, Kate Steinle or Marilyn Pharris? They were murdered in California because city and county government preferred to protect illegal aliens, with numerous deportations. Thanks to President Trump, we know the criminal communities.

"Between February 4 and February 10, ICE issued 2,285 detainer requests nationwide. Of those, 540 were sent to 10 jurisdictions that ICE says "do not comply with detainers on a routine basis." Those 10 counties are:

New York, New York

Kern, California

Clark, Nevada

San Diego, California

Orange, California

San Bernardino, California

Santa Barbara, California

Travis, Texas

King, Washington"
