# RECYCLING ..... It's the Law!

## SPECIAL ITEMS

**TREES & BRUSH** Less than 6" in diameter. **Untreated** lumber & pallets. Place on brush pile.

**BATTERIES** Lead Acid (vehicle) - Put in aluminum can trailer. Flashlight and tool - Put in black bin by employee shed

### CONCRETE BLOCK & MASONRY MATERIALS

Place on stockpile.



### USED MOTOR OIL

Do not mix with other liquids. Pour carefully into above-ground tank.

Fluorescent tubes are accepted! Place above waste oil tank.

ALUMINUM CANS are appreciated! Place in drum near recycling rollaway.



## WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

**Δ Demolition or Building Material in excess of 2 garbage bags or cans**

- Δ Gasoline
- Δ Liquid Paint
- Δ Oil-water mix
- Δ Carpet/pad, vinyl and linoleum in excess of 250 square feet
- Δ Solvents
- Δ Oil-gas mixture
- Δ Anti-freeze

## CONTAINERS

Rinse, **Crush** (esp. milk jugs), and **Place** in 28-yard rollaway container. No bags, please!

### PLASTICS:

Put caps/lids in trash.

Rinse container and flatten whenever possible.



Soda bottles and jugs



Milk, water and detergent bottles



# 3—#7 containers : beverages, food, cat litter, ice cream pails, flower pots & trays, medicine/pill bottles, clean gas or motor oil, cheese/yogurt, clear/rigid clam shell packaging, 55-gal drums, plastic furniture/and toys

**Aseptic Containers:** cartons/boxes used for



**CANS:** Bi-Metal & Steel (food & empty aerosol)

Tuck loose steel can lids into can & squeeze to hold in.

### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

Rinse to prevent spilling and odor. Put lids in trash.



## DO NOT INCLUDE:

Styrofoam egg cartons, hot beverage cups/plates, packing pieces/peanuts, Plastic film/wrap/bags, CD cases, Vinyl windows/siding, Aluminum foil, Glass windows (esp. broken), Mirrors, Ceramics, Clay pots

## PAPERS

Mix together and package in paper bag. Place in 8-yard receptacle.

### MIXED PAPER

INCLUDES:

Newspaper  
Magazines  
Catalogues  
Phonebooks



Egg Cartons (paper only)  
Office-type paper (white, color, shredded, etc.)  
Envelopes (including window envelopes)  
Container Board (cereal, tissue boxes, soda cartons, etc.)  
Books (hardcover, paperback)  
Paper rolls & tubes  
Grocery bags  
Corrugated cardboard (flattened)  
Pizza boxes (without the pizza!)

## DO NOT INCLUDE

Food	Metal
Tissue products	Heavily soiled paper or cardboard
Paper toweling	Plastic bags or liners
