

City of Silver Bay response to Executive Order 20-33 Stay at Home

Following an update from the City of Silver Bay in response to Governor Walz's "Stay at Home" Executive Order 20-33, relating to the COVID-19 Pandemic. The City of Silver Bay's ability to serve you is our top priority and our staff is working diligently to provide critical services while honoring the Executive Order. In order to do so, we have implemented a few changes to reduce the exposure risk among staff in critical roles.

All public facilities are closed to the public. Below is an update of each Department to provide you guidance during this time:

CITY HALL: City staff are available during normal business hours Monday-Friday from 8:00am - 4:00pm. For information you can view the City's website at www.silverbay.com or you can contact us at 218-226-4408. Please utilize the mail system or the City's drop box for payments. All essential City business functions including processing vendor payments, permitting, and payroll will continue.

POLICE: For emergencies please call 911. The officers are still providing care and coverage for our City, they are just providing it temporarily in a different way. If you need to report a crime, wish to speak with a police officer, want to request documents or fill out paperwork, please call 218-226-4486 or 218-834-8385. Someone from the Police Department or Lake County Dispatch will answer and put you in touch with the appropriate personnel.

FIRE: For emergencies please call 911. The Fire Department will be responding as normal with personal protection protocols being enforced.

WATER/SEWER: For questions, please call 218-226-3663 or Mike Miller at 218-220-0166. There should be no disruptions in your services. All drinking water standards set by the MDH and effluent limits in our permit by the MPCA will continue to be met.

LIQUOR STORE: To order for curbside pickup only, please contact 218-226-3106. Hours of operations are Monday - Saturday from 9:00am-8:00pm. Sundays are closed.

LIBRARY: The Library is closed due to the

Executive Order.

PARKS AND RECREATION: For questions, please call 218-226-4214. Playgrounds, tennis courts, ballfields, basketball court, and skate park are closed to the public. The Department is preparing for summer programs, but it is still unknown what programs, if any, will be available.

PUBLIC WORKS: For questions, please call 218-226-4552. Staff hours are Monday-Thursday from 6:00am to 4:00pm. Staff are working on spring cleanup. They have started street sweeping and will be working on pothole patching on our streets and boulevard restorations as weather allows.

MARINA: The Marina is currently closed. Pending opening is May 15, 2020.

BLACK BEACH PARK: Black Beach Park is closed. Pending opening is May 15, 2020.

BLACK BEACH CAMPGROUND: The Campground is nearing construction completion. A ribbon cutting ceremony is tentatively planned for June 1st. The campground website and reservation system is coming soon. First day of camping is planned for June 25th, 2020.

AIRPORT: Airport runway is closed.

GOLF COURSE: Golf Course is currently closed until construction of the septic system is completed.

REUNION HALL: The building is closed for rental.

CEMETERY: Open for visitation.

MARY MAC BUSINESS CENTER: Closed for non-business activities. There is no walking or gym use for recreation. If you have questions for a business, please contact them directly for their operation plans.

OTHER NOTES:

1. The City understands there may be financial hardship during this time. We encourage utility payments to still be made; however, the City has waived late fees on First Quarter utility payments and will not be conducting shutoffs relating to non-payment of First Quarter utilities at this time. Second Quarter utility bills will be sent out prior to the end of the month. Please place payments in the City drop box or utilize the online payment system. Just note that additional fees apply for online payments. Please call 218-226-4408 with questions.

2. The next City Council meeting is scheduled for Monday, April 20th at 7:00pm. We are

planning to conduct the meeting via video conference. Information on how to tune into the meeting will be posted on the City website. If you have questions or would like to submit a public comment prior to the meeting, please email to lanaf@silverbay.com. We are working on other City Board and Commission meetings to be set up via teleconferencing as well.

3. We ask that if you see City staff working on your boulevard or streets during these next few weeks, that you practice social distancing. If you need assistance, please contact City staff via the phone numbers listed above.

4. Minnesotans are encouraged to stay close to home and strongly discouraged from engaging in unnecessary travel.
