Protecting Ugandan Girls' Access to School and Sports

- I am selling and delivering beautiful, top-quality faux wreaths to fundraise for the materials to create reusable sanitary supply kits to send a summer camp in Uganda that is going into its 6th year of supporting health and opportunity for kids in Uganda. This past summer, the camp served over 1,000 kids.
- Girls in Uganda do not have good access to sanitary supplies, which means that once a month most have to stay home roughly 7 days. Missing that much school and accompanying activities like sports is associated with a high early drop-out rate and lifelong ripple effects of increased poverty and poorer health.
- •This is personal for me because 3 years ago I temporarily lost access to my education and sport due to an injury that sidelined me for a few months. I can't imagine being sidelined once a week for life.
- •With each \$50 dollars we raise, we can help 10 girls like me stay in school. With each wreath purchased, we can help 4 girls. My goal is to help at least 200 girls.
