

The Concert Hall, with its high vaulted ceiling, has a seating capacity of up to 2680 and a maximum stage area of 224 square meters.

Following the concert, pack up and return to the hotel.





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

#### NOTES:

- Exchange Rate / Currency: Costs are based on USD/AUD Exchange Rate of \$0.80 (as of August 22, 2017). If the Exchange Rate changes by more than 3%, World Projects retains the right to recost the tour.
