Parks Report -

A preconstruction meeting for the third phase of the John & Mary Rudolph Nature Area was held Thursday, November 29, 2018 with Beam Designs, architect and J & J Schlaegel, contractor. It was determined that the F-4 permit from the Army Corps of Engineers as discussed in the last meeting is not required for this project. The Ohio EPA Notice of Intent application renewal has been submitted and approved.

The committee also recommended changing the health insurance plan from National General to Medical Mutual with a \$5,000 deductible as outlined in the attachment from Waypoint Benefits.
