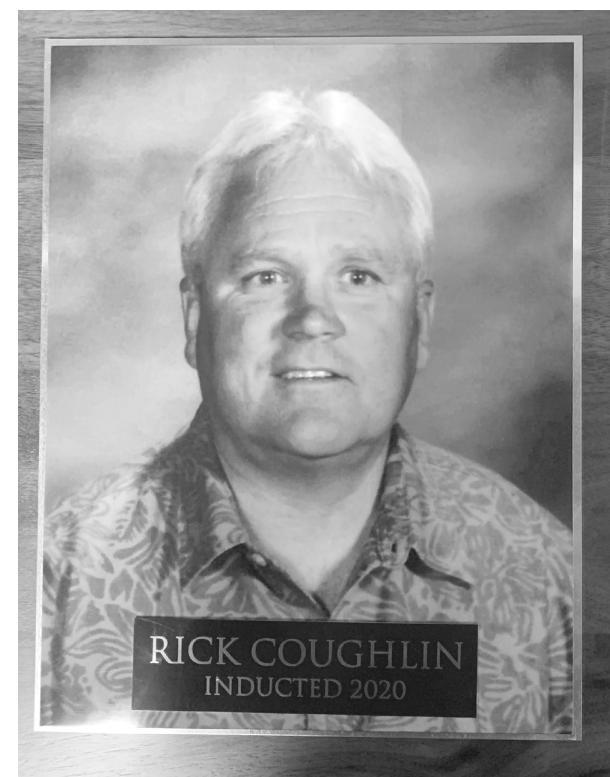

Coughlin to be inducted into Silver Bay's Hockey Wall of Fame



Rick Coughlin was born and raised in Cloquet, MN. He played football, baseball, hockey and basketball as a youth. In High School he was captain of the (1969) Cloquet H.S. Football team and the (1970) Baseball team. Rick attended Bemidji State University where he played baseball for two years, then finished his college degree at UMD.

In the Fall of 1978, Rick was hired to teach Industrial Arts in Silver Bay where he also coached Jr. High Football and was Assistant Boys' H.S. Hockey Coach. He was then hired as Head H.S. Football Coach for one year in 1981 and as Head Boys' H.S. Hockey Coach in 1985 for two years.

In 1988 Rick was hired as Head H.S. Football & Baseball Coach at Two Harbors H.S. where he coached until his retirement in 2015.

Rick worked with Roger Koster for 25 years at the Silver Bay Blue Line Summer Hockey Camp, and he worked with the Blue Line Club to build the lockers in the Boys' H.S. locker room.

Rick is grateful for the friendships he made in his coaching and teaching career.

The induction honoring Rick will be held Friday, January 31 at Silver Bay's Rukavina Arena right before the puck drops for the North Shore Storm Varsity game vs Hibbing at 7:00 pm. Everyone is welcome to attend and support Rick and the North Shore Storm.
