

#### St. Kateri Tekakwitha July 14

Kateri Tekakwitha was born in 1656 in the Mohawk village of Ossernenon. Her mother was an Algonquin, who was captured by the Mohawks. She took a Mohawk chief for her husband.

Smallpox swept through the tribe when Kateri was four years old. Many in her tribe, as well as her entire family died. Kateri survived, but was so badly scarred that she often hid her face from other members of the tribe.

When Kateri was 19, she became a Catholic, taking a vow of chastity. Her decision was not well received by many members of the tribe, who saw the white missionaries as the bearers of evil (smallpox). For her own safety, she traveled to a Christian Native American community south of Montreal.

Kateri was known to perform acts of self-mortification, a popular practice at the time, to show her faithfulness. However, due to her general poor health, these practices may well have contributed to her death. Just five years after her conversion to Catholicism, she passed away at the age of 24, on April 17, 1680.

Her name, Kateri, is the Mohawk form of Catherine, which she took from St. Catherine of Siena. She was canonized on October 21, 2012. She is the patroness of ecology and the environment, people in exile, and Native Americans.



A Flower for Your Mary Garden— Rosemary

Rosemary is an edible herb, which grows as

a perennial in southern climates, but as a fragile annual in the north. Its leaves can be dried and stored to use sparingly as an accent to almost any kind of meat dish.

A medieval story tells that
Mary would wash the Christ
Child's clothing and lay them
on rosemary bushes to dry.
When removed, the bush
released it's scent in praise
and gratitude to God.
