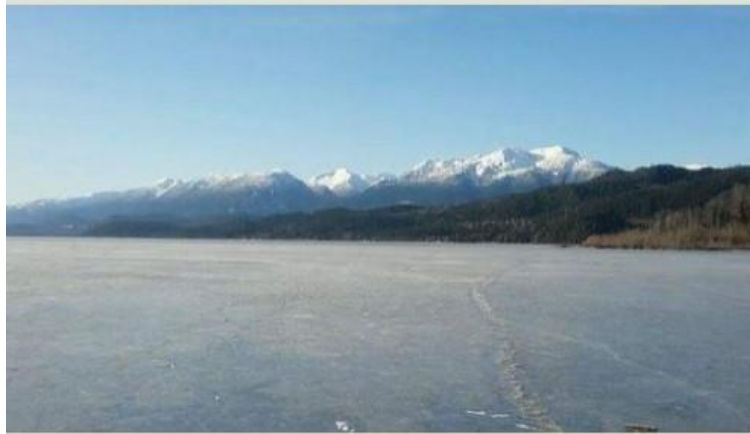


## Connor Sabo Fishing Reports for February 1, 2017 at 4:50pm

Temperatures have been fluctuating quite a bit and we had a huge down pour of rain and warm temperatures so it did a number on our lake ice and i thought that was it for the year but mother nature gave us another cold snap and we are back down to below Zero which has hardened up the edges allowing a person to get back to the thick ice.. always check the ice thickness before you go out and make sure it is at least 3-4 inches thick before you decide to head out! As for fish i managed to land 7 Cutthroat trout, a few Squaw fish and a nice Bull trout! Nothing huge but all in all a great day on Lakelse Lake! I was using my [Ugly stik](#) rod, roe cured with [Pro-cure](#) and also natural and uncured roe as well as hooks and swivels made by [Mustad](#)!

I was lucky to get out on the Lakelse Lake ice for a couple days in a row and the fishing completely picked up. I changed my bait to uncured fish roe and also worms and slowly noticed bigger and bigger fish coming in! Eventually I lost count of how many fish came through the holes countless Cutthroat and Dolly Varden Char and even got a 24 inch Bull Trout up to the hole but the hook some how popped out which was very disappointing but they do not get that big for no reason!
