THANKSGIVING RECIPE

This recipe is a twist on the traditional fruit salad.
Its warmth and flavor mix well with all

HOT FRUIT SALAD

- 1-24 oz chunky applesauce
- 1-16 oz can peaches, sliced
- 1-16 oz can pears, sliced
- 1-16 oz can apricot halves, sliced
- 1-16 oz can mandarin oranges
- 1-20 oz can pineapple chunks
- 1-20 oz cherry pie filling
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon

spread applesauce on bottom
of glass pan.

drain cans of fruit; mix.

pour over applesauce.

pour pie filling over fruit.

mix cinnamon and brown sugar,
sprinkle over fruit.

bake one hour at 350 degrees.
