
RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

TOWN OF KREMMLING REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING May 1, 2019

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Grover Pryor called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Trustees present: Holly Martinson, Gina Schroeder, Jason Wikberg, Leo Pesch, Dave Sammons, and Erik Woog. Staff present: Town Manager Dan Stoltman, Police Chief Jamie Lucas, Public Works Director Jason Bock, and Interim Town Clerk Joanna Eaton.

SCHROEDER MOVED TO APPROVE THE REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF APRIL 17, 2019. PESCH SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

WOOG MOVED TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURES FROM APRIL 18, 2019 THROUGH MAY 1ST, 2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$103,497.33. SAMMONS SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

WIKBERG MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS PRESENTED. SCHROEDER SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.

Jim Ward, owner of the Grand West Trailer Park spoke in regard to the Town not allowing him to move in a tenth trailer. Jim has been speaking with Town Manager Dan Stoltman on a response back from the Towns Attorney on this matter. He is asking the town permission to allow a tenth trailer. Hopefully by next meeting Dan will bring to the board a letter from the Towns Attorney, Jim's Attorney, Zoning Code, and other thoughts. Jim thanked the board for listening and will be back at the at next board meeting.

There were no more citizen comments.

Mayoral Announcements, Proclamations, Appointments-

- Mayor Grover Pryor promoted Police Officer Robert Dillon to the Rank of Sergeant.
- There was a vacancy on the Planning and Zoning Commission. Scott Spade was appointed.

Police Chief Report-

- Chief Lucas wanted to thank Robert Dillon for coming out of retirement, to help the Town when there was a need for police officers. He then wanted to speak on the incident that occurred at 500 N 12 St, Monday afternoon. That location is in the Rayner Trailer park, which is within county limits. A County Deputy was first involved in a highspeed pursuit with a known criminal. The Kremmling Police was there in assistance, they stood out for 7 hours waiting for him to come out of his home. They eventually were forced to pack up and leave. The warrants were attempted to be obtain from the on-call judge. Chief Lucas wants the public to know that the law enforcement did not fail the community. The technology from the judicial failed, the judge on call could not attach her signature digitally through the computer. The Judge then told everyone to leave. Chief Lucas supports the law enforcement in every decision, the judge saw differently in this situation.
- Trustee Schroeder brought up the Junk Ordinance, now that the snow is melting and asked Chief Lucas what the plan is from here. He responded that he had a department meeting and will be moving forward and start educating the public on resolving the issues. A Town cleanup day may be something the Town will see in the future.
- The open house was successful.

The Public Works Director reported-

- Jason Bock said that the flocculator at the water plant are fixed.
- This year we shouldn't see a water shortage.
- The Public Works staff have been working on drainage with all this rain.
- Blading Jackson in the next week or so.
- Bill Jones came back for the season he will start cleaning up the cemetery.

Discussion & Action on the Propose Purchasing Policy- Manager Stoltman went through much of the 2018 minutes, he found this topic was left without a conclusion. There has not been a draft policy yet

and it does not appear that a policy has been approved. He brought to the board a tired system that allows purchasing and grant discretion of the Town Manager at the Department Head level if under a specific amount and budgeted for. Anything not budgeted for will have to go the Board up to a certain amount.


PESCH MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE PURCHASING POLICY. WOOG SECONDED. ALL "AYE" VOTES.
