Cart Rules & Etiquette

- Golf carts are to remain on the paths beyond the painted stripes on each hole. Under no circumstance should you ever drive a cart up beside the green unless you have a health waiver. A good rule of thumb is don't get off the cart path within 50 yards of the green. Also:
 - O Don't drive between the green and the houses on number 1.
 - O Don't drive between 2 green and 3 tee box.
 - O Don't drive between 4 green and 5 tee box.
 - O Don't drive between 8 green and 9 tee box.
 - O Don't drive between 9 green and 1 tee box.
- Drivers of golf carts will use the 90 degree rule to approach balls in the fairway. **DO NOT DRIVE STRAIGHT DOWN THE FAIRWAY.**
- Practice will be limited to the practice areas so designated.
- Slower groups should allow faster groups to play through.
- No fishing for golf balls from ponds or picking up range balls.
- No more than **five (5) players** in any group when other golfers are on the course.
- ALL ALCOHOL MUST BE PURCHASED THROUGH THE PRO SHOP OR BAR. No alcohol is to be brought on the club premises. This is a STATE & ABC regulation.

A lot of these rules seem like common sense but we wanted to make sure everyone is aware of them. We don't have a course marshal so we need to police ourselves. It's our course and we should all want to take care of it.
