

GUSTAVE H. KAUSCH

1903 - 1988

Gustave H. Kausch, 84 of Sebewaing, passed away Thursday afternoon, March 24 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe, following a brief illness.

Mr. Kausch was born in Germany on April 19, 1903, the son of Edward and Margarete (Gerwin) Kausch. He came to America in 1923, moving to Sebewaing, and was married to Mabel M. Wissner in Immanuel Lutheran Church Sept. 1, 1934.

He was cellar foreman at Sebewaing Brewing Company for 30 years prior to its closing in 1965, and he was a member of Immanuel Church and Lutheran Laymen's League.

Surviving are his wife, Mabel of Sebewaing; two sons, Frederick of Owendale and Curtis of Peoria, Ill.; one daughter, Mrs. Dennis (Gretchen) Haist of Sebewaing; nine grandchildren, and three brothers, Conrad of Warren, Richard of Tallahassee, Fla., and Walter of LeMasa, Ca.

Three brothers, John, Edward and William, and one sister, Magdalene Schoel, preceded their brother in death.
