Obstacles

 Things that should or must be avoided in putting the regional plan in place, or things that represent conflict that must be resolved to attain a need or want.

Major topical categories that separate the needs, wants, and obstacles in to key focus areas **Level of Service** Governance 1st Order 2nd Order 3rd Order

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


Prioritizing the Issues

Identifies the issues into "tiers" based on logical progression. 2nd order issues depend on how the 1st order issues are addressed; 3rd order depend on how both 1st and 2nd order issues are addressed, and so forth. 1st order issues are foundational and therefore call for a higher priority.
