Percentages in **red** indicate schools participating in the CEP program.

What this would indicate to me...if the school district knows that forms are not being returned for the lunch program, and the district decides to participate in the CEP program...maybe as many as 20% of the students are going hungry as indicated by the percentage differences when Direct Certification is use to make the determination.

The whole district is eligible to participate in the CEP program.
