

Tips:

- You do not have to invite a person + guest unless they have a significant other
- · If you are inviting some children, you need to invite all
- NEVER state "Adults only", send RSVP cards with the invited guest's names already filled out instead
- NEVER include your Gift Registry information in your invitation



The map (facing up) goes on top of the RSVP card (facing up), which has the RSVP envelope flap over it, that goes on top of the reception card (facing up), and it all lays on top of the Invitation (facing up). This package slides in to the Inner envelope as shown, the Inner Envelope is slid in to the Outer envelope with the Invitees names facing up.
