


Winter Orchestra Concert

Dear Orchestra Students and Parents/Guardians,



The Jolliff orchestras will be performing a winter concert **Thursday, December 17 at 7:00 p.m.** in the Jolliff auditorium.

ATTENDANCE:

As stated in the Jolliff Orchestra Handbook and the CPS Attendance Performance Policy distributed in September, concert participation is **required**. Mrs. Rosenberg can help arrange a carpool if needed. Students are expected to remain for the entire concert. *Contact Mrs. Rosenberg with attendance concerns immediately.*

GRADING:

This concert is **TWO performance grades**. To receive full credit, students must report on time, be dressed appropriately, have all materials, and display appropriate concert etiquette. *The Grade Book Key that the students received at the beginning of the year outlines point deductions for violations of the above mentioned (and it is also on the orchestra website).*

ATTIRE:

6th Grade: White Dress Shirt (any sleeve length) 7th & 8th Grade: White Tuxedo Shirt
Solid Black Dress Pants (to the ankle)
Black Dress Shoes (with Black Socks)

7th & 8th Grade Only: Bowtie & Cummerbund (owned by the Jolliff Orchestra)

**Please do not wear jewelry that will cause a distraction (i.e. big necklaces or earrings, jingly bracelets)*



REPORT TIME & LOCATION:

6:00 p.m., 8th grade: chorus room, 7th grade: orchestra room, 6th grade: band room

VALUABLES:

Do not leave valuables in the unpacking room, as it will not be locked during the concert.

ELECTRONICS:

The auditorium is a **RED ZONE**. Mrs. Rosenberg (or a volunteer helping Mrs. Rosenberg) will confiscate all electronic devices out during this time. Students will also receive a significant grade reduction as this is a violation of both appropriate concert etiquette and the CPS "Bring Your Own Device" policy.

The orchestra classes are diligently preparing and it is sure to be a great performance! Students thank you for your efforts, and parents/guardians thank you for your support.
