Installation on a rough stone wall



Here the frame was screwed on a piece of TS44 to provide a distance from the rough stone wall



Aluminum brackets were custom made to fix the frame and keep the same distance from the wall.



Another view of the custom bracket at the junction of two extrusions.

For both supporting and fixing the frame and strengthen the junction.



Here (Quebec, Canada) the standard 13 Oz. vinyl was replaced by outdoor polyester.

The polyester does not become stiffer when the cold is there, allowing to install outdoor banners even during cold seasons.

Small PVC segments are used to maintain the graphic, always starting on the top of the frame.



Then the segments are removed and replaced by longer PVC inserts.



The PVC insert is cut at the end of the frame.



During the installation, the first frame is finished.



The two frames are respectively 7'H x 18'W and 14'H x 10'W.
