Population has declined rapidly in recent years as more and more farm families have moved to the cities. The highest population figure was around 19,000 in the early part of this century.

Owen county was formed in 1819 out of portions of Scott, Gallatin and Franklin counties and contains 367 square miles. The county and city both were named after Col. Abraham Owen, an early pioneer famous for his Indian fights, who died in the Battle of Tippecanoe in In-



The next executive meeting of the company is planned in six weeks at the executive offices in Memphis, Tenn.




