2021 Scholarship Application

The Elmhurst Panhellenic Foundation exists for the charitable intent of raising funds for scholarships for Elmhurst women. These scholarships are awarded annually to high school senior and college women, residing in Elmhurst or attending an Elmhurst school. The scholarships are one-year awards and may vary in amount. Candidates may reapply in subsequent years if they meet the eligibility requirements and are not a past recipient of an Elmhurst Panhellenic scholarship.

Eligibility

Applicant must be:

A female, legal resident of Elmhurst, Illinois and/or attending an Elmhurst school and either

1. A graduating high school senior or current college student OR
2. Re-enrolling or continuing at an accredited college, university, community college, technical or trade school.
3. And have not previously received a scholarship from Elmhurst Panhellenic Foundation.

Instructions to Applicants

1. All parts of the application must be completed. It should be typed or legibly printed in black ink. Typed information may be affixed to the application and labeled accordingly. All required supporting documents must also be provided, including the applicant's **Student Aid Report (SAR)** showing your **name** and **Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)** only – no need for the entire form from the FAFSA application.
2. **The completed application is due by midnight, Friday March 12th.** Completed hard copies of the application must be postmarked or hand delivered to the mailbox of Scholarship Chairman Molly Barrett, 221 S. Fairview, Elmhurst. **Please email any questions to: Molly Barrett at mollybarrett@yahoo.com. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**

Selection

Members of the Scholarship Committee and the Foundation's Board of Directors select scholarship recipients based upon a blind evaluation of the following areas: financial need, academic achievement, extracurricular activities, quality of completed application, letters of recommendation, and paid or volunteer work.

All decisions are wholly within the discretion of the Foundation. The Foundation may elect to award multiple scholarships or none. The Foundation reserves the right to change or rescind an award if it is discovered that any information provided in the application process is false, or if the financial or academic circumstances of the applicant have changed. All decisions are final.

Notification & Monetary Disbursement

Scholarship winners will be notified in early April 2021 and invited with parents/guardians to a Foundation Presentation Ceremony, Thursday, April 8th, as well as recognized at York's Scholarship Night. Recipients will complete an additional form with remittance information that certifies their application. Scholarships will be distributed in August, directly to the college, university, or technical school of attendance.
