

**VILLAGE OF WOODSBURGH
LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER
USE OF TENTS IN FRONT YARD**

I, LEE ISRAEL, the Mayor of the Village of Woodsburgh, in accordance with and furtherance of a proclamation of State of Emergency in the Village previously executed by me on this date pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, and in the interest of both public safety and the protection of property and public health, declare the following:

Gatherings inside of buildings and dwellings, on private property, including private residences, creates a potential danger during the current pandemic, as determined by various federal, state and local health departments. Health departments have recommended outdoor congregation of people as a safer alternative to indoor gatherings. This order is intended to align the Village Code restrictions with the advice provided by the various health departments. Specifically, the Village Code prohibits the placement of tents in certain locations on private property, including in a front yard. To enable private property owners to provide for safe gatherings, this Order hereby supersedes the provisions of Village Code §150-39.1(A)(3), and authorizes the installation, placement or maintenance of a temporary tent or similar structure in a front yard. This Order does not supersede any other Village Code provisions, including Chapter 136 and any requirements for a building permit or other Building Department authorization related to the placement, installation or maintenance of a tent or similar structure on private property, which provisions shall continue to apply. This Order also does not supersede any orders of the Governor, any state department or Nassau County department, relating to gatherings.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect for a five day period, unless sooner rescinded, superseded or amended by Order of the

Mayor, or as otherwise provided by law. This Order may also be renewed in five day increments or otherwise as provided by law.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law Section 24(5).

LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Village of Woodsburgh (the "Village"), Nassau County, New York effective on September 21, 2020.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to continuing emergency conditions produced by: public health concerns related to the Coronavirus (COVID-19).


Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of this municipality.

The State of Emergency shall be limited to the following geographical area: within the entire Village.

This State of Emergency shall remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As Chief Executive of this municipality, I have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.

I hereby direct all departments of the Village to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, ~~public infrastructure and other such~~ emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
