2022-2023 ADW TUITION ASSISTANCE

The Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Program is available for students in grades PK-12 applying to or currently enrolled in Catholic schools for the 2022-2023 school year. All tuition assistance obtained through the Archdiocese is based on demonstrated financial need, which must be demonstrated each year to qualify.

Applications are due in early December. TADS financial aid and assessment manages the process on behalf of Archdiocese of Washington Catholic schools. Please note that you only need to complete one form for all children in a family, whether elementary school students or high school students, even if seeking tuition assistance for children attending different schools. To apply, log into your TADS account and select "Financial Aid Application".

Families must submit an application for ADW Tuition Assistance before applying for additional school-based tuition assistance.
