- The two proposed homes to be built by Developmental Disabilities were discussed. Jason Umstot gave an overview of the homes with input from Carolyn Carnes and Mike Cloud. Ed Wasem, the zoning inspector, stated that the zoning resolution mentions single family dwellings, but not group home. Carolyn Carnes stated that case law considers group homes as single family dwellings and can provide examples. Additional traffic caused by the group homes and the effect on property values were also discussed.
- Melodie Bogantz brought up the need for the township to have a compliance officer for the Credit Card. Bill Bogantz nominated Bill Siegel as the compliance officer. Dave Cole seconded the nomination. The vote: Bill Siegel abstained. Bill Bogantz and Dave Cole voted YES. The motion passed. Bill Siegel is the credit card compliance officer for the township credit card with Park National Bank.
- Bill Siegel updated the trustees on the culvert issues in the township.

- Resolution 02-2020 for Driveway Culvert Installation was discussed. Dave Cole made a motion to adopt the resolution. Bill Bogantz seconded the resolution. The Driveway Culvert resolution 02-2020 passed with all yes votes. The fee of \$50 will take effect June 15th 2020.

- Credit card bill is not available
- Trustees discussed getting industrial shelving for storing files in the township building.
- Trustees discussed chain link fencing around the cemetery.
