Opportunities for Lenten Gifts at the Altar

March 8 & 15: You are invited to bring new Teddy Bears to the altar. Our mission team will take these to the Methodist Children's Home when we go on our mission trip there at the end of March. Teddy Bears will be given to children by counselors and chaplains when a child will benefit from it.
