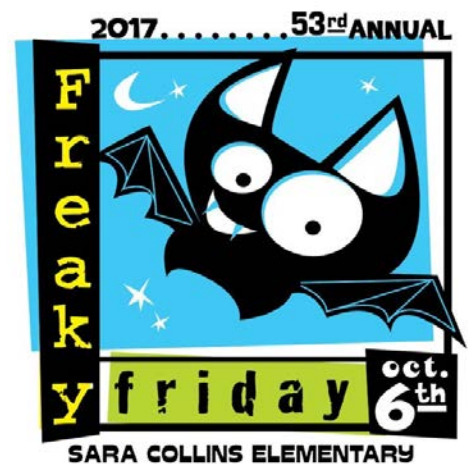

TECH ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 6TH FROM 3:30PM-7:30PM.

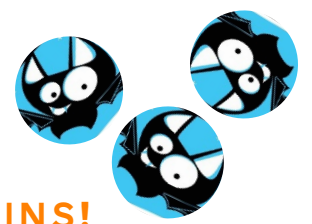

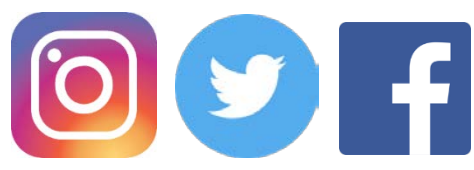

NEW SPACES AT SARA COLLINS!



As our new construction nears completion, we continue to “Construct Future Graduates” at Sara Collins. During the last year, we have expanded our school building by five classrooms, divided one existing adult bathroom into two, and added a new, large covered play area on the kindergarten and 1st grade playground. The adult bathroom was divided into two to provide more facilities for our visitors and staff on the front hallway.

During the last five years, our overall student population has increased by more than 40 students. While this number changes every year depending on transitions of families into and out of our attendance area, approved IB applications, and students assigned to our school based on needs, there has been a steady increase over the years. Therefore, our planning department had the forethought to approve the addition of two kindergarten classrooms on the back of the middle hallway and three additional, smaller classrooms upstairs including a resource classroom in the middle.

At this time, there are only a few punch list items left to be completed. However, our students and teachers have already been able to enjoy the additional, newly enhanced spaces. In addition, we have created a partnership with Washington Center to construct a Nature Trail in the slightly wooded area on the end of our playground. This will be accessible to students at Sara Collins and Washington Center during the school day. Our PTA, in collaboration with Washington Center PTA, is collecting donations and hosting a brick campaign to raise funds for this project.
